

# Foreword

As each student leaves Elon College, he carries with him a part of her light. But the light does not grow dimmer. Rather, it becomes brighter for it reaches greater distances.

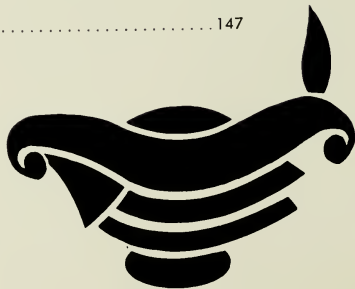

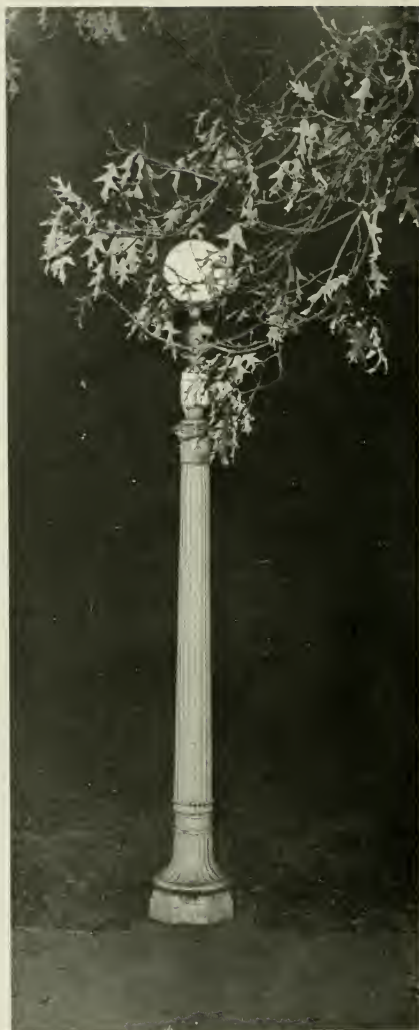

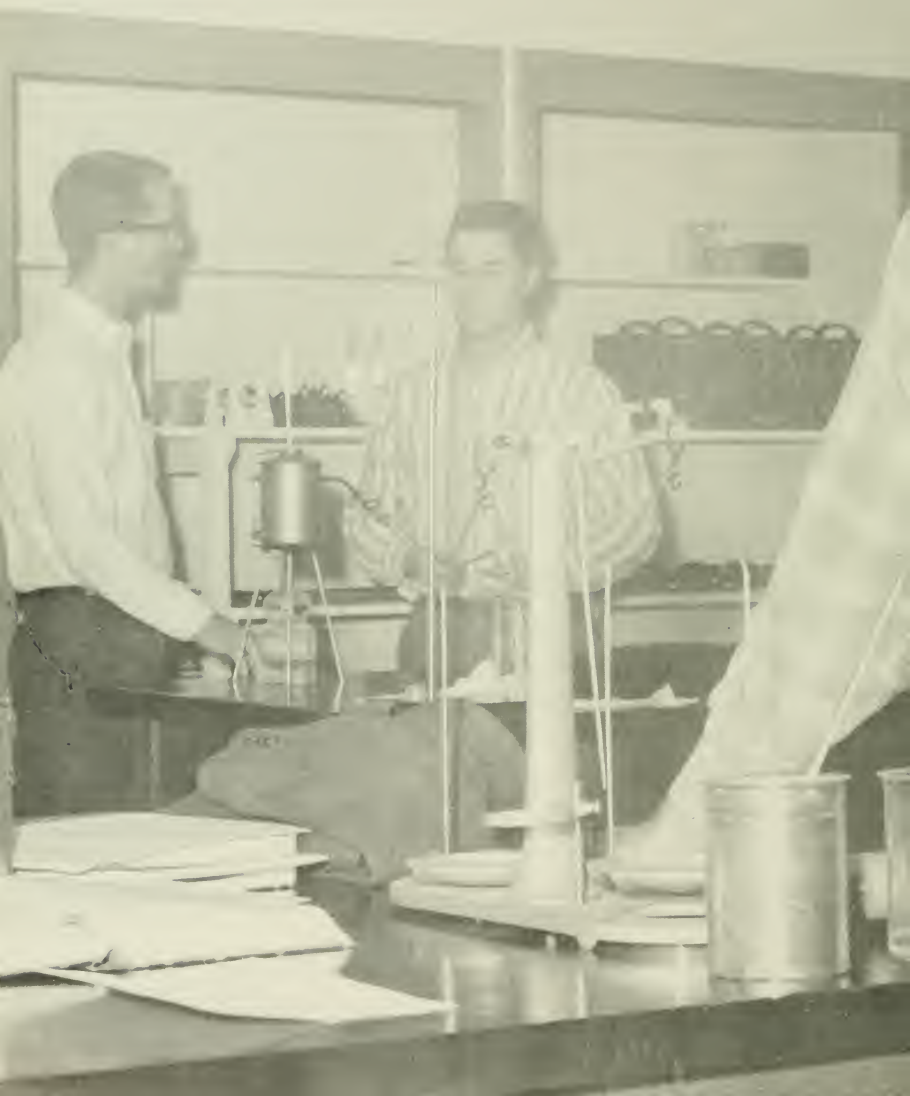
## Light Shines Forever

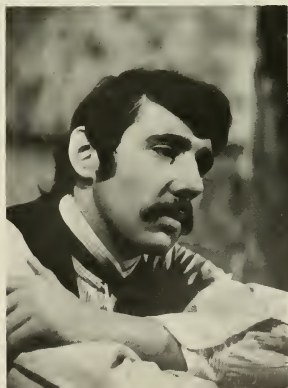
