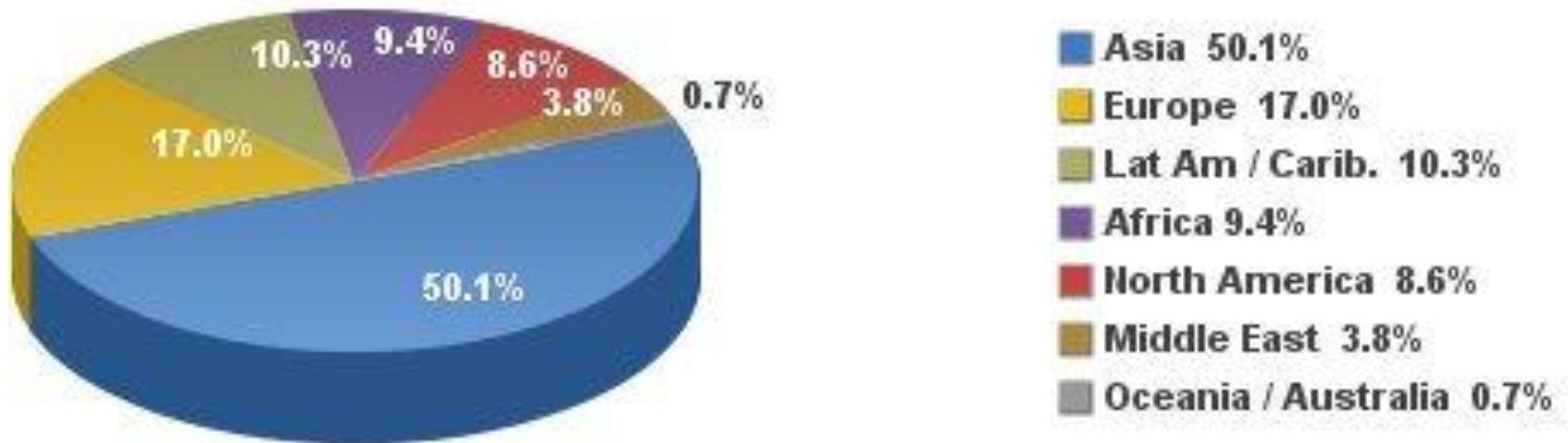

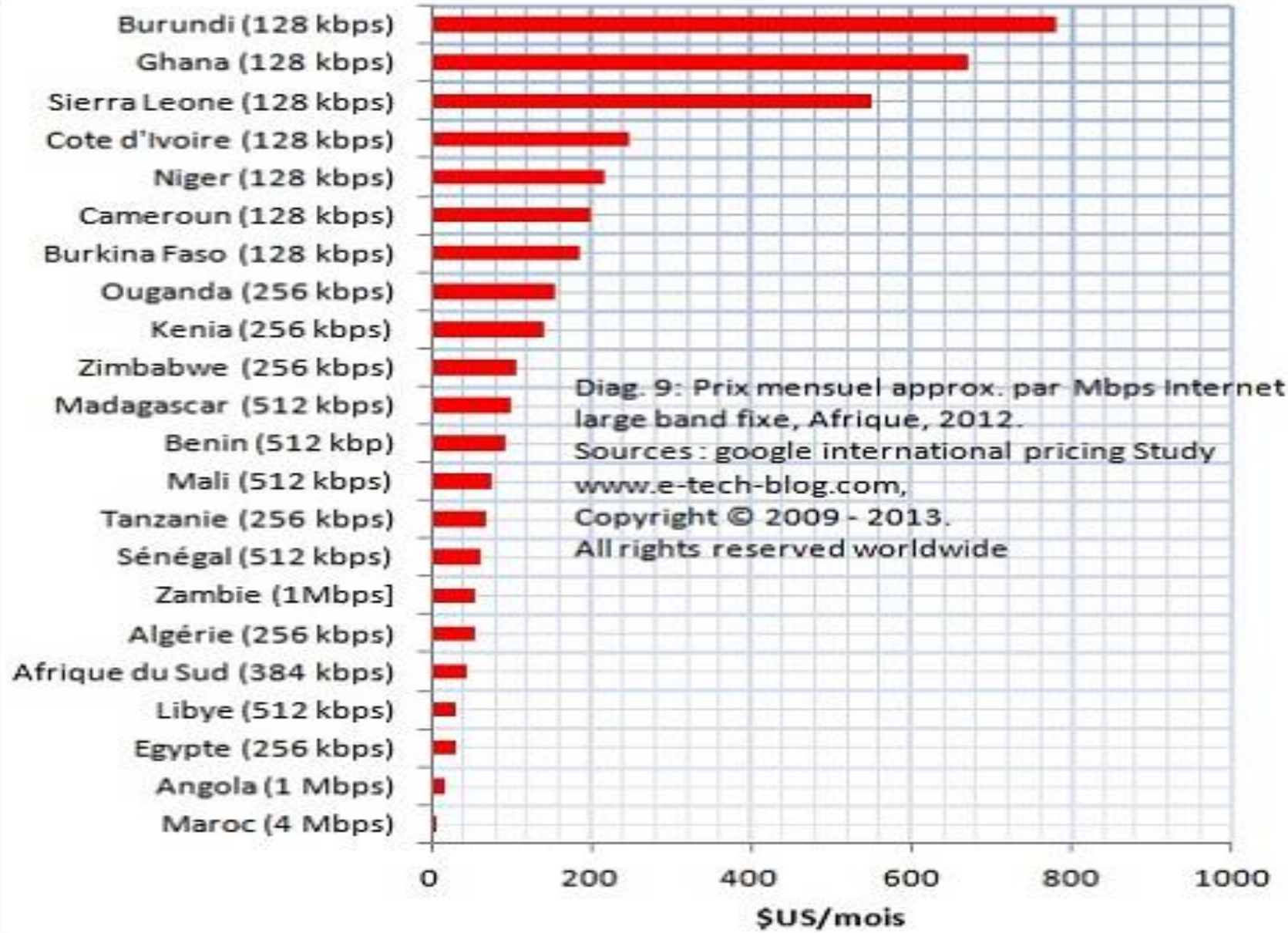
Internet Users in the World by Regions - 2017 Q1

Uses of WikiFundu

It is currently operational in 13 countries via 3 programs:

- *Wikipack Africa for outreach work of Wikipedians in Algeria, Cameroon, Côte d'Ivoire, Egypt, Ghana, Nigeria, South Africa, Tanzania and Uganda (soon Togo)*
- *WikiChallenge African Schools : getting 9-11 kids in primary school write articles for Wikidia. Part of the Orange Foundation's Digital Schools Project in Guinea, Tunisia, Madagascar, and Mali.*
- *WikiAfrica Schools – introduces, trains, and supports South African students (14-16) as they incorporate a Wikipedia article-writing program into their curriculums. It is supported by lettera27.*
