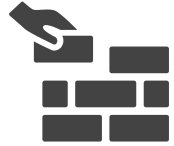
01 Movement Charter update

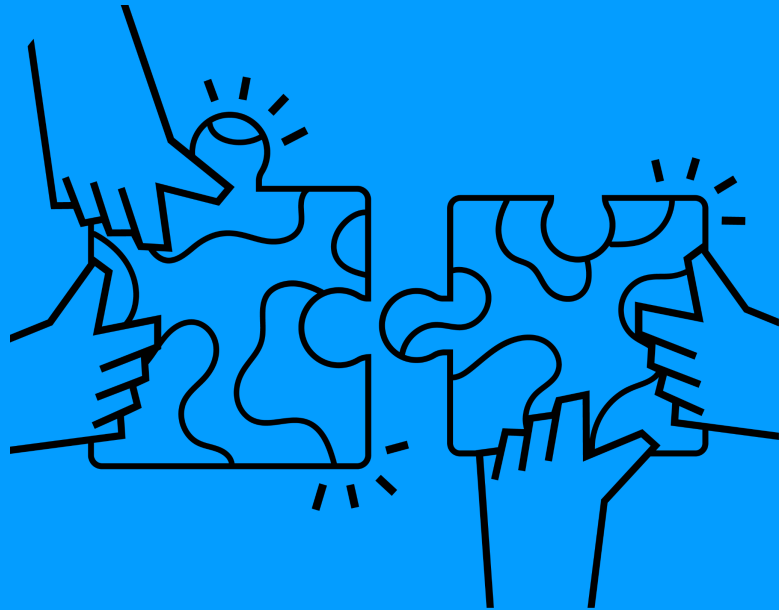
