01 Movement Charter update


Drafting Committee

- Committee is now well set up with
 - \circ a good fortnightly meeting rhythm,
 - \circ emerging subcommittees, and
 - \circ ~ asynchronous work processes.
- There are regular monthly updates being <u>published on meta</u>.
- There is a communications subcommittee that is setting up engagement model and plan for community engagement.

02 Hubs Update


Hubs Dialogue

 - Supported by the next global workshop happening on March 12.
