NEW YORK: THERE WERE 2 CARS ON TRACK, PLUS 3 CARS DUE LATE THIS AFTERNOON AT LONG ISLAND CITY AND 1 CAR AT WEEHAWKEN, N.J. AT THIS WRITING ONLY 1 CAR OF FOWLS MIXED WITH A FEW MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS WERE AVAILABLE FOR OPEN MARKET TRADING. MARKET VERY FIRM. SUPPLIES WERE FAR SHORT OF TRADE REQUIREMENTS. TRUCK RECEIPTS TO DEALERS WERE LIGHT; FOWLS EXTREMELY SHORT. TRADING WAS ACTIVE AND ALL OFFERINGS CLEARED AT PREVAILING FIGURES. MARKET EXTREMELY FIRM, MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS LIMITED AND MET ACTIVE TRADING. A FEW GRADE B AND C BROILERS SOLD AT 28 AND 25½ PER LB RESPECTIVELY. THE QUOTATIONS LISTED ABOVE ARE MAXIMUM OPA CEILING LEVELS AND NOT BASED ON ACTUAL SELLING VALUES. 21½ TRUCK LOADS DELIVERED TO DEALERS UP TO 12 NOON TODAY INCLUDED: ½ PENNSYLVANIA LEGHORN, TOTAL ½ BROILERS; 4½ DELAWARE CROSS, 1¼ MARYLAND CROSS, ½ VIRGINIA RED AND ROCKS, TOTAL 7 FRYERS; 8½ DELAWARE CROSS, 3¼ MARYLAND CROSS, ½ VIRGINIA CROSSES AND REDS, TOTAL 12 ROASTERS; 1 VIRGINIA FOWL, 1 PENNSYLVANIA MIXED WITH ROCK FRYERS, CROSS AND ROCK ROASTERS AND LEGHORN BROILERS. PLUS 2 LOADS OF DELAWARE CROSSES DUE. THERE IS ONE CAR REPORTED FOR TOMORROW. DIRECT REC. RECEIVED UP UNTIL LATE MORNING TODAY 168,175 POUNDS.

PHILADELPHIA: MARKET VERY FIRM. FOWL CONTINUED SCARCE. DEMAND ACTIVE FOR ALL CLASSES.

BALTIMORE: LIVE POULTRY RECEIPTS VERY LIGHT, MARKET FIRM, PRICES UNCHANGED.

BOSTON: POULTRY PRICES UNCHANGED FROM YESTERDAY. THERE WAS A SMALL LOAD OF BROILERS ON THE MARKET TODAY, BUT IT WAS QUICKLY CLEANED UP. THERE WERE NO FOWL AVAILABLE. SUPPLIES OF ALL CLASSES OF POULTRY WERE EXTREMELY LIMITED.

WASHINGTON: LIVE POULTRY MARKET FIRM. PRICES UNCHANGED.

NEW YORK CITY PRICES ARE BROADCAST FROM WGY, SCHENECTADY DAILY AT 6:20 P.M. WOR, NEW YORK CITY AT 6:30 A.M. DAILY AND WHCU, ITHACA, AT 12 NOON, THE FOLLOWING DAY.
