Rosen began noticing vacant retail spaces in iconic shopping areas such as Miracle Mile, Lincoln Road, and Wynwood. Often the these empty spaces had nothing but paper sheets on their windows. Bingo! In his mind Rosen could see these dark treasures restored to their original vitality with art projects which showcased Miami's special culture as well as the diverse international influences that the city welcomes.

Rosen paired with his favorite Spanish artists, Domingo Zapata and actor/artist Jordi Molla, to create his first major art pop-up on the corner of Alhambra and Salzedo streets in Coral Gables. In addition to traditional paintings, there were paintings on genuine matador jackets and wearable art. The opening featured master Flamenco dancers and guitarists. The show was exquisite and profitable. Art pop ups have been a focus since 2017.
