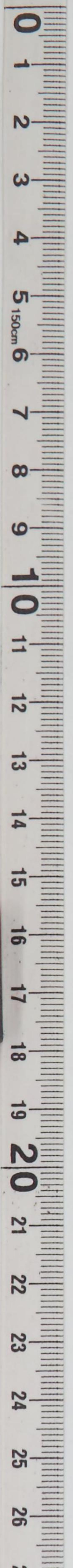

1. It has been observed that replacement issues of dependent housing chinaware and silverware are frequently not of the same design and pattern as originally placed in the housing unit. In order to correct this condition, it is requested that action be initiated to standardize these items and to confine future procurement to the standardized pattern or design.

2. Since wet mops, corn brooms and other items are no longer being procured from indigenous sources, careful attention should be given to the requisitioning of these items as resale items in order to insure their continued availability in the commissaries.

1. Background on this action is concerned with comments which G-1 requested from G-4 re the revision of "Info for Deps Coming to the Tokyo Area." By C/N G-4 concurred in the current issue of the pamphlet which is dtd 18 Jan 49 with certain deletions of items not considered essential for procurement by deps.

2. In view of no action having been taken on the above, G-4 prepared a C/N to G-1, QM and Hq Comdt in which it was noted that wet mops and vacuum cleaners are no longer procured for issue. Furthermore, it was suggested that the obsolete edition of the publication "Info for Deps Coming to the Tokyo Area" be w/drawn and current issue be substituted. G-4 pointed out that there appears to be no logical reason why the pattern of tableware and silverware cannot be such that replacements can be made of the same pattern and design.

3. The QM has replied to G-4 C/N and states that 8A is aware of the fact that in the essential procurement of dep hsg items many were obtained which later proved to be of inferior quality. The QM has cited 8A msg in which the interested parties have been advised that effort should be made to improve the quality and design of dep hsg furniture and that all addressees submit suggestions for recommended changes or improvements which should arrive in 8A hq by 31 Jul 49. Atchd to the QM C/N is a prpsd ltr to the CG 8A in which it is requested that action be initiated to standardize the items of chinaware and silverware and to confine future procurement to standardized patterns. Further, it~~xxx~~ is pointed out that wet mops, corn brooms and certain other items are not being procured from indigenous sources; therefore, careful attn should be given to the requisitioning of these items to insure their continued availability in the commissaries.

4. Since there appear to be no irregularities in the prpsd ltr, no G-4 action is required other than to fwd ltr to AG indicating approval and requesting signature and dispatch. This has been accomplished by C/N 2.

1. For G-1

a. It is noted that inclosure 1 to C/N (1) is an obsolete publication dated 26 Sep 47, whereas the current publication is dated 18 Jan 49. It is suggested that the obsolete edition be withdrawn and a current issue be substituted.

b. In C/N 4, subject: Dependent Housing Supplies, 7 May 49, G-4 furnished comment on the 18 Jan 49 edition of "General Information for Dependents Coming to the Tokyo Area" and recommended that electric iron and stand type ash tray be deleted.

c. Since C/N (1) involves matters pertaining to the operations of QM and Hq Comdt it appears desirable to have their comments before further action by G-4.

d. It is pointed out that wet mops and vacuum cleaners are no longer procured for issue nor are they contained in inclosure 2 to the 18 Jan 49 information pamphlet.

2. For QM

a. G-4 has authorized procurement of sufficient items and quantities to meet the essential dependent housing needs. However, it appears that the quality furnished does not measure up to the standards which are within the production capabilities of the Japanese.

b. There appears to be no logical reason why the pattern of table ware and silverware cannot be such that replacements can be made of same pattern and design.

c. Since towels, wet mops, corn brooms and other items obtainable from local commissary facilities are no longer procured, careful supervision should be given to forecasting these items to assure their continued availability.

3. For Hq Comdt

a. Eighth Army reported on hand and under procurement sufficient items of authorized dependent housing furnishings to meet the normal requirements in Japan. Therefore, it appears that shortages are due to faulty requisitioning procedure and/or inequitable distribution to the various housing units in the

SUBJECT: Request for Rugs

1. Problem: Issue of Rugs to G-1.
2. Corres Ref - C/N #1, G-1 to Hqs Comdt thru G-4, above subject, 12 Jul 49, requests two additional rugs be issued over and above normal allowance provided in T/A 20-130, FEC, 24 Aug 48, to correct accoustical difficulties in G-1 conference room.
3. Additional data: New rugs for the purpose indicated are not available and the issue of same is not within policy above allowance authorized. However, there are available rugs from dependent housing which have been turned in as damaged property which are not considered suitable for repair and re-issue for dependent housing requirements. There is no monetary credit involved in the turn-in of damaged dependent housing rugs. Although it is not within policy to furnish supplies over and above established allowances, the request in this instance has received favorable consideration on the basis of a one-time issue without establishment of a policy change. The nature of the property available for issue and the fact that no monetary adjustments are involved has been the basis of the approval.
4. Decision: to request the Hq Comdt to issue two rugs to G-1 as requested. This action is not a change in policy and is a one time action only.

1. At the present time there is a shortage of household furnishings including kitchen and dining room equipment in the Tokyo Area. Co-existent with this situation is a restriction on the amount of baggage that may be brought to Japan. This limitation is imposed on the basis that dependent houses are satisfactorily furnished for reasonably comfortable living. This is not the case.

2. Instances have been reported as follows:

a. No lamps available for issue. Those that become available from time to time are of such poor quality as to be worthless.

b. No uniforms for servants.

c. Tableware and chinaware. No replacements - occupants being expected to use what was found when they moved into the quarters. Replacements when available in chinaware and silverware do not match. Some occupants have had to buy cups and saucers and dinner plates.

d. No percolators - electric.

e. No mops.

f. No end tables or night tables.

g. Shortage of irons, vacuum cleaners and other equipment (which when available are unserviceable).

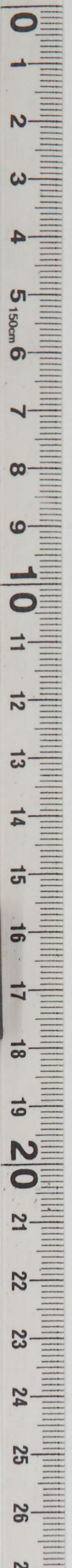
h. No glassware or stemware.

i. Refrigerators of Japanese manufacture are unreliable.

j. No rugs.

3. It is desired to point out that rugs, furniture and other items of furnishings previously issued and those now being issued are of poor quality, and to emphasize the statement in paragraph 1 herein that present instructions prevented and still prevent individuals from bringing household furnishings to Japan. Until such time as this situation is remedied, household furnishings issued should be of such quality to permit a reasonable standard of living.
