



The Richmond and Lexington turn pike was built 1834. toll was collected at five toll houses until 1871; The only toll house now standing on this road; known as U.S. 25; was built 1834, And is located half way between Lexington and Richmond.

A BEAUTIFUL SCENE ON THE KENTUCKY RIVER,
THIS BRIDGE WAS BUILT IN 1870. ON THE SIGHT OF THE OLD CLAYS FERRY; AND TAKE THE NAME OF CLAYS FERRY BRIDGE; TOLL WAS TAKEN ON THIS BRIDGE BY A BRIDGE CO. UNTIL 1929, THEN SOLD TO THE STATE FOR \$205,000 AND FREED IN 1931. *IT IS LOCATED ONE MI. SOUTH OF THE KENTUCKY WHITTLERS MUSEUM.*
