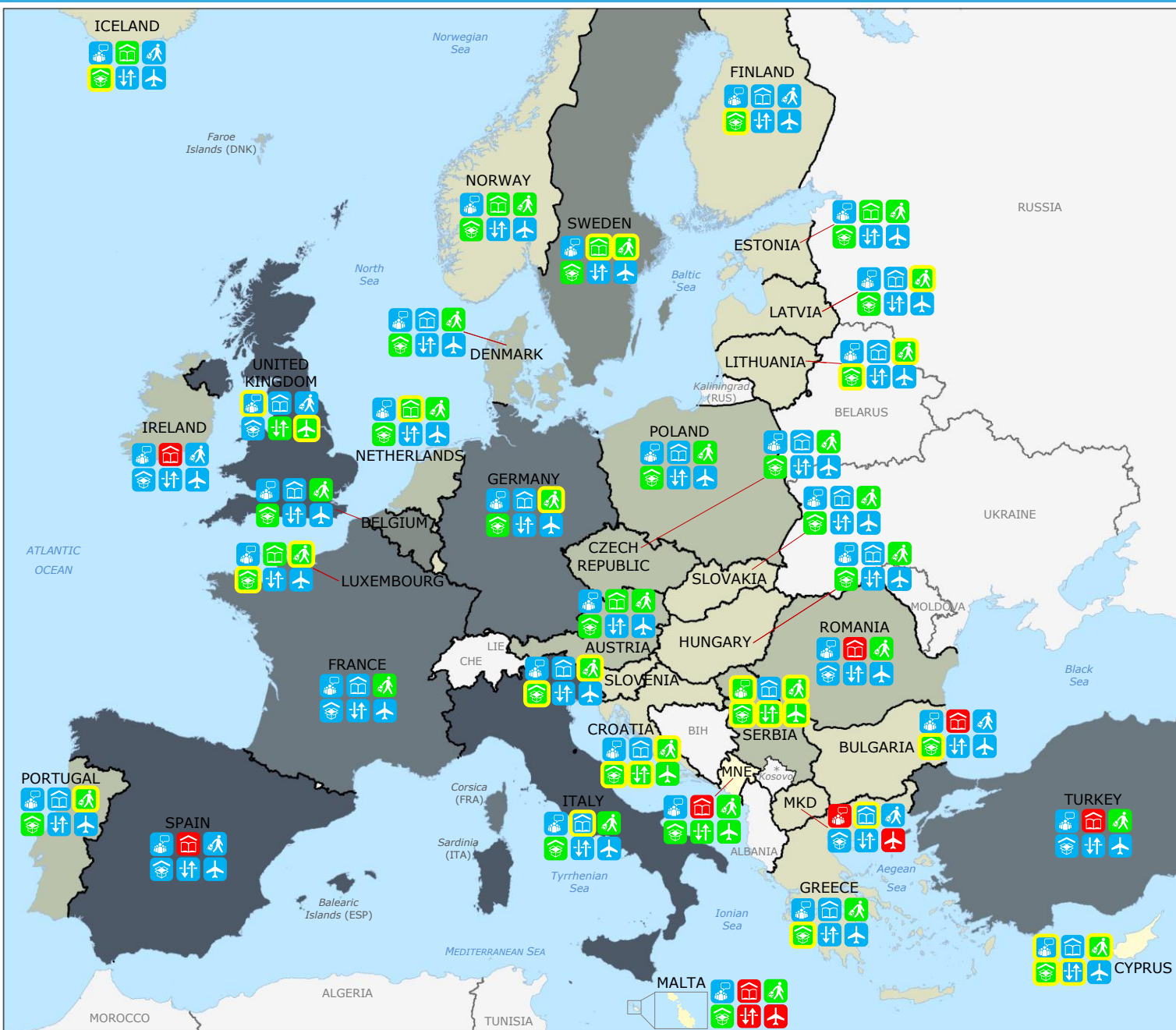


# COVID-19 restriction measures in EUCPM Member States and Participating States
