
Gender Gap

The content problem

Greek Wikipedia has few articles, especially articles concerning women's issues.

A strong feminist movement existed in the country during the late seventies and it raised many serious issues concerning women's **reproductive rights** (abortions, free contraception), **sexuality** and **prostitution**. Despite its struggles against the traditional roles of woman in the Greek family and its serious impact in Greek society, there is still not even one article written in Wikipedia about it.



Ο σκοπός μας

Greek Wikipedia has few articles, especially articles concerning women's issues. For example: a strong feminist movement existed in the country during the late seventies and it raised many serious issues concerning women's reproductive rights (abortions, free contraception), sexuality and prostitution. Despite its struggles against the traditional roles of woman in the Greek family and its serious impact in Greek society, there is still not even one article written in Wikipedia about it.

Moreover, the synthesis of the Greek Wikipedia community is largely male oriented.

In the foreign literature, the limited participation of women in Wikipedia is often attributed to causes such as:
"Wikipedia is sexist. Women lack confidence. Women have less spare time. Women have problems with the editing interface. Editing is tedious. Women have fewer opportunities to develop social relationships than on other websites".


The same common beliefs also prevail in Greece.


Following the outreach method we used last year with success (talks, meetings with feminist groups and female targeted groups, edit-a-thons) in a larger scale we want to raise awareness of these problems and increase female participation in Wikipedia projects, Wikimedia community and at the same with creating more articles of female interest.





Is the internet sexist?


Have you been a victim of sexism in the internet?








Do articles about women haven female of male POV?

Θα θέλατε να συμμετάσχετε στη συγγραφή λημμάτων για τη γυναίκα;




Why don't you want to edit Wikipedia about women?

- Just not interested 45%
- Don't have time 40%
- I don't trust it anyway 5%
- I wouldn't follow the stereotype that I would write about female matters just because I am female 2%



Females and Males in elwiki



Results

- One inactive female reactivated
- Two female Wikipedia editors expressed interest to join the user group
- Many female editors did more than 10 edits
- We start to become a recognisable entity
- Feminist organisations are inspired to work with us in the future





Teachings and drawbacks

- Focusing in just adding content fails.
- Katherine Maher: "Your edit count is not your contribution" (CEE Meeting, 2017)
- Gaining trust takes time. Needs a lot of effort and teamwork.
- Female organisations have archives. They can provide texts, material for citations, etc.
