SUMMARY OF RELEVANT POINTS

(A.N. This document shows that some preparations for World War II were started under Japanese Government direction as early as 1938 by this institution. Its obvious connection with the government and the "Total War Research Institute" are of particular interest.)

This institute was organized by virtue of Cabinet Order No. 2, 2 June 1935, as is stated in this document, and it was an official government org. The officers are all high ranking officials of the government, per attached list of names. For instance the vice president of the Planning Board was appointed as one of the directors and when he retired from the vice-presidency of the Planning Board, he was automatically released from the directorship of this institute. And every change of officers, or the budget of the institute and all other things of this institute was to be reported to the premier and/or had to get sanction from the premier and received advice from the president of the Planning Board.
