MEMORANDUM FOR: THE IMPERIAL JAPANESE GOVERNMENT.
THROUGH : Central Liaison Office, Tokyo.
SUBJECT : Correction to Steel Fishing Vessel Construction List.

1. Reference is memorandum for the Imperial Japanese Government from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, file AG 560 (13 May 46) ESS/IN (SCAFIN - 949), dated 13 May 1946, subject: "Authorization for Construction of Steel Fishing Vessels," which grants permission for the construction of 416 steel fishing vessels as listed in Inclosure 1 of above letter.

2. The memorandum is corrected as follows:

a. The eight 270 gross tons trawlers listed on line eleven of the second page of the Inclosure are to be constructed by the Mitsubishi-Kobe Shipyard at Kobe.

b. Add the following two steel trawlers to the list:
