ATRECCES. On the Inonty-Second day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, a Preclamation was insued by the President of the United States, containing, among other things the following, to wit

Dhat on the first day of January, in the year of our Lind one thousand eight hundred and eight hundred and eight porcons held as Claves within any State or designated part of a State, the people whereof shall then be in rebellion against the United States, shall be then, theneeferth, and FOREVER FREE, and the executive government of the united states, including the military and naval authorities thereof, will reconside and maintain THE FREEDOM of such persons, and will do no act or acts to repress such persons, or any of them, in any efforts they may make for their actual freedom

"That the Executive will, on the first day of January aforesaid, by prestamation, designate the States and parts of States, if any, in which the people thereof respectively thall then be in rebellion against the United States, and the fact that any State, or the people thereof shall on that day be in good faith represented in the Congress of the United States by members charen thereto at elections wherein a majority of the qualified veters of such Elate thall have erticipated, shall, in the ahmner of strong countervailing testimony be deemed conclusive evidence that such Etate and the people thereof are not then in rebellion against the United States!

Mow: therefore, I, ABRAHAM LINCOLN, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED SEATES, by virtue of the power in me vested as Commander-in-Chief of the Army and Navy of the United States in time of actual armed Redellion against the authority and government of the United Elates, and as a fit and necessary war measure for suppressing said Rebellion, do, on this first day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and in accordance with my purpose to to do, publicly prestains for the full period of one hundred days from the day of the first above-mentioned order, and designate, an the States and parts of States wherein the people thereof respectively are this day in rebellion against the United States, the following, to wis: ARKANSAS, TREAS, LOUISIANA (except the Parishes of St. Bernard, Plaquemines, Jefferem, St. John, St. Tharles, St. James, Seconsism, Stemmerican, Gerre Bonne, La Fourabe, St. Mary, St. Martin, and Orleans, including the City of Orleans), Mississippi, Alabama, Florida. GEORGIA, SOUTH CAROLINA, NORTH CAROLINA, AND VIRGINIA (except the forty-sight counties designated as West Virginia, and also the counties of Berkeley, Secoman, Herthampton, Elizabeth City, Herk, Princese Selnn, and Herfolk, including the cities of Herfolk and Pertinenth), and which excepted parts are for the present left precisely as if this Proclamation were not issued.

To Chad by wirtue of the power and for the purpose aforesaid, I do order and declare that ALL PERSONS HELD AS SLAYES within said designated States and parts of States are, AND HERCEFORWARD SHALL BE FREE! and that the Executive Severagent of the United States, including the Military and March Southerities thereof, will recognize and maintain the freedom of said persons.

Cled I hereby enjoin upon the people so declared to be free, to abtain from all violence, UNLESS IN NECESSARY CELFDEFENCE, and I recommend to them that in all cases, when allowed, they LABOR FAIRINGLE. FOR REASONABLE WAGES,


