One approach: structured tasks


Structured tasks break down editing workflows into steps that guide and teach newcomers.

- ✓ Works in the background - most users will never see it. Does not intrude until it really needs to.
- ✓ Highly effective against long term abusers (LTA) with its blocking functionality, while minimising false positives.

- The examine and test interfaces are **awesome** for learning the ropes. They let you look at specific edits and filters in detail, without real-world consequences.
- Keep an eye on the log.
