NOTE -

THE STRAIGHT LINE "AB" EXTENDING FROM CENTRE OF FOUNDATION OF OLD BRICK WALL ON CHARLOTTE ST. TO WEST FACE OF GATE POST ON CHAPEL STREET COINCIDES GENERALLY WITH REMAINS OF OLD FENCE AND LINE OF OCCUPATION.

THE BROWN DOTTED LINE IS A 5 FOOT OFFSET FROM LINE "AB". MEASUREMENTS TAKEN FROM IT (AT THE POINTS INDICATED BY a b c & d.) TO THE FOUNDATION OF NEW HOUSE SHOWS LOCATION OF HOUSE WITH REFERENCE TO LINE "AB" NEW 8" WALL BUILT ON TOP AND FLUSH WITH EAST FACE OF OLD 14" FOUNDATION.

Note: At the request of Mr. Langdon Cheves I this day relocated that part of the line A-B lying between B and d. At points indicated on map I found remains of a fence together with bricks & stumps showing clearly line of occupation. I also noted a marked difference in elevation of the surface on each side of this line and in places a number of brick bats & stones on the surface & partially buried up to and along the west side of the line, but which do not appear beyond the line.
