



SITUATION

- Damage assessments are ongoing following the earthquake that hit the south-eastern province of Perugia on 30 October. According to the Italian INGV the quake was 6.5 magnitude and depth 10 km. USGS estimated a shaking up to "Severe" for 50 000 people. The epicentre was located 5.5 km north-west of Norcia, Perugia province.
- As of 31 October early morning (UTC), Italian Civil Protection reported that at least 20 people have been injured and hundreds of buildings have been damaged in the regions of Umbria and Marche. Several roads still remain closed and rail traffic has been disrupted in Umbria, Marche and Abruzzo regions. According to local media at least 28 000 people have been evacuated.
