

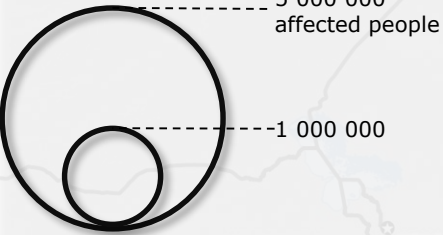

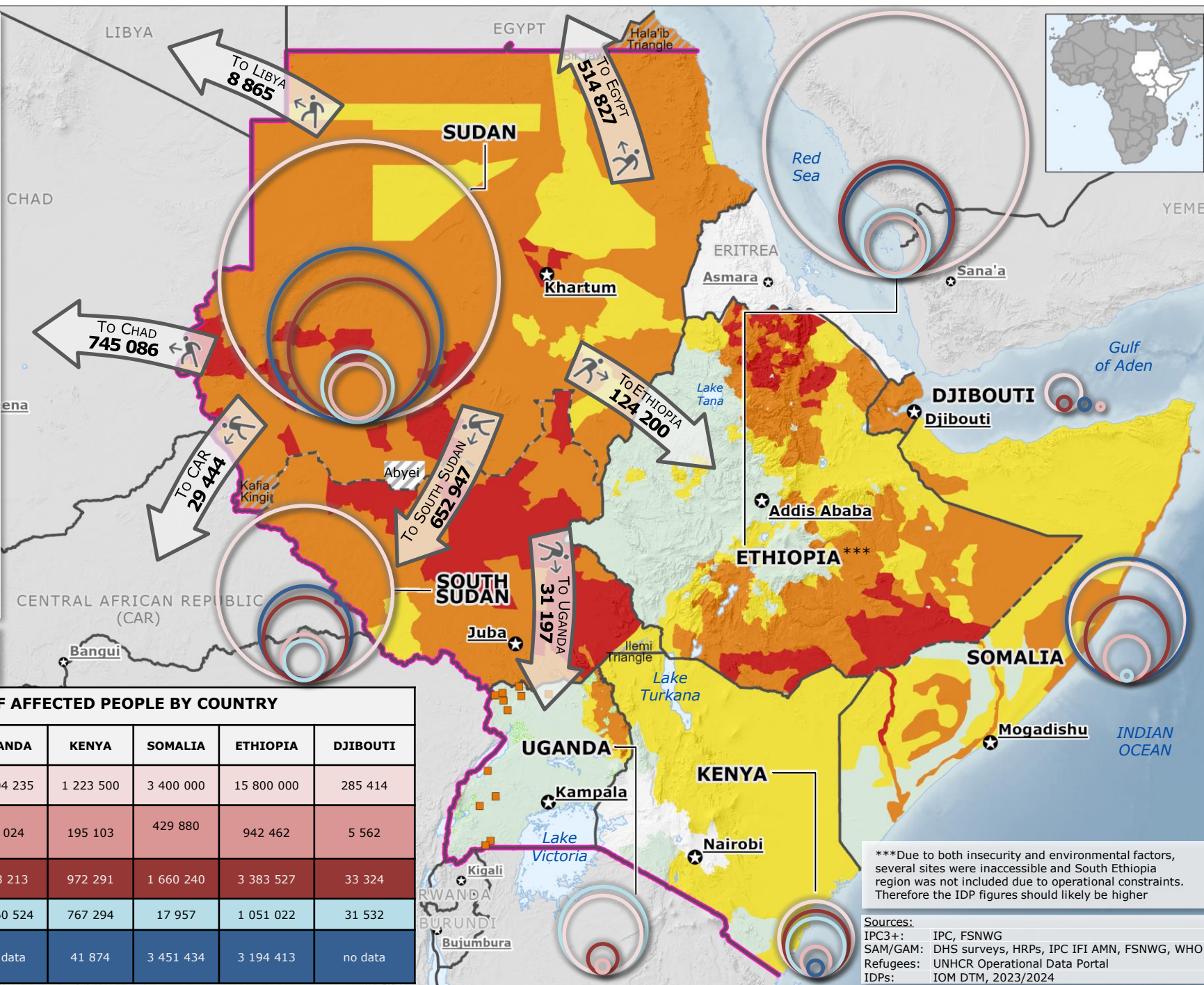


Population movement from Sudan since April 2023
