A part of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry Ordinance No. 64 (concerning Limitation of the Disposition of the Property of Agricultural Associations) shall hereby be revised as follows:

Article 2-(2). No agricultural association may, under any pretext whatsoever, increase any periodical pay for its officers, employees or laborers such as salaries, wages, allowances or bonuses, or any temporary pay such as monetary rewards for services or retirement allowances based on its regulations, bylaws and the like, without obtaining prior approval of a prefectural governor in respect of a city, town or village agricultural association, and prior approval of the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry in respect of a prefectural agricultural association and the National Agricultural Association.

Article 3-(2). No agricultural association shall destroy any kind of document which is maintained by the association, or remove it from its office.

Any agricultural association shall make adequate records showing loans, dividends and all other disposal of fixed funds since August, 1947 and maintain them in perfect conditions.

Supplementary Provision:

The present Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.
