According to Dr. Ctt, the Subject seemed quite anxious to answer all these questions and even offered to give fuller answers, if required. He added that he had taken many pictures while in the Soviet Union, some of which were of the Soviet officials he met in hoscow.

- 5. The personalities of interest whose Covation has set seem to be CCLUB (fnu), a coviet vice Counsul who is an assistant to Ivan Schotter, and Yuri Vollaid. He also set a Finnish Communist named Rick (fnu), she was sitting with CCLUB and VCAONIN at a Finnish restaurant. On one occasion CCCCATCD asked CCLUB over to his apartment for a drink and suggested that COLUB bring VCAONIN and the Finnish Communist along than the Finnish Communist die not turn up dor a drink, [CCCATCD] asked his Russian guests why. One of the Russians allegedly replied that, "so do not like to associate with these Finnish Communists. Hany of these Communists who would betray their own country would also betray us too; you can't trust them."
- 6. On one occasion LONGATED saw the First's passport and noted that he had travelled to practically every country in the world.
- 7. In [CONTERN ] USIS file there is a letter dated 16 April 1956, in which [CONTERN ] asks permission to go to the Soviet Union. The letter reads as follows:

"I have been invited by the Soviet Academy of Sciences to give one or two lectures in Moscow at the end of this work. The date of departure from Helsinki has not yet been fixed, but I should like to inform you at this time of the plane. The visit will not exceed three or four days.

On the other hand, if [LOHMATER] went in April and his last date of entry from the USER was in mid-July, it looks as if he took two trips also. However, his file only refers to one.
