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



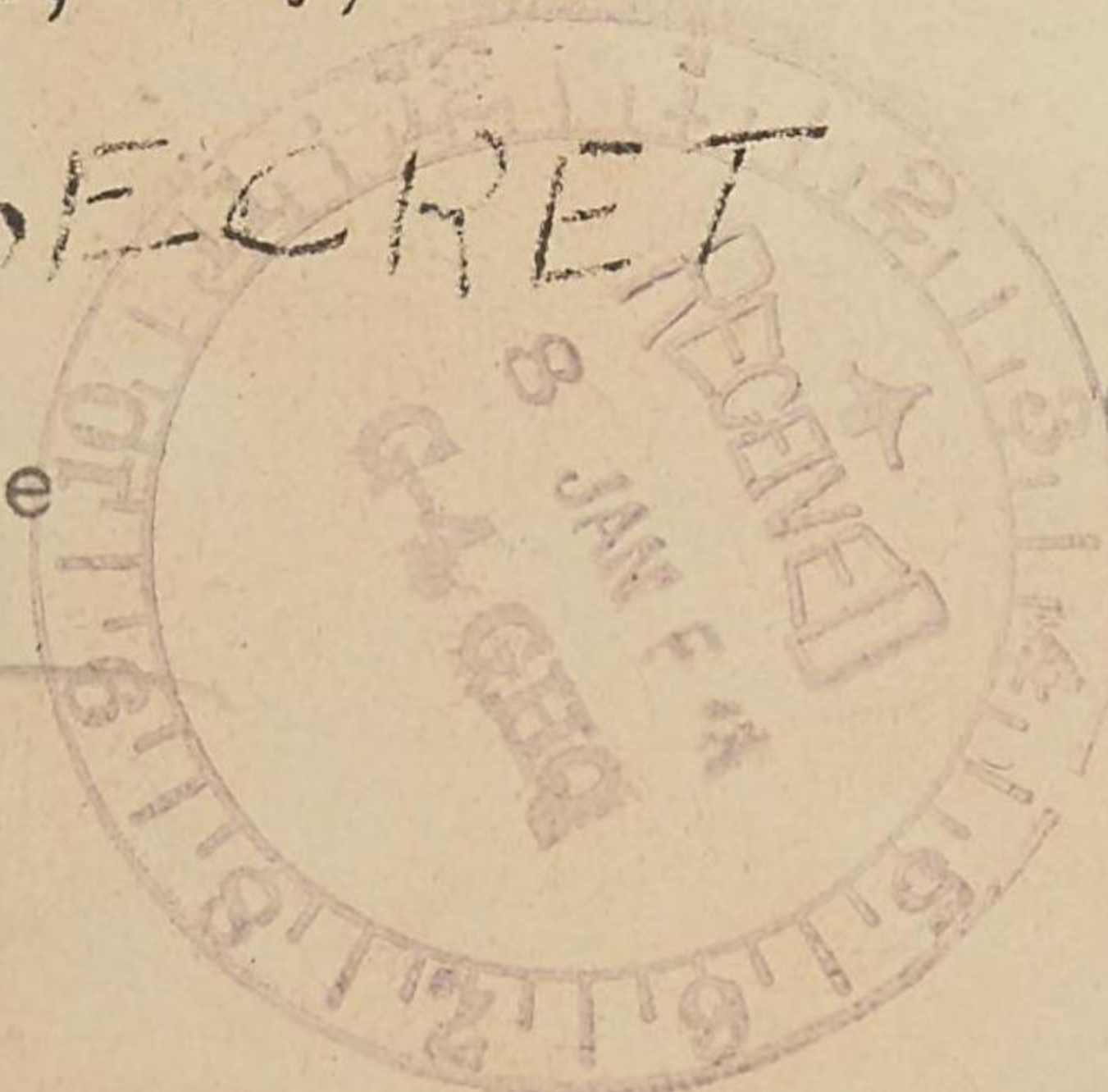

1. Concur in note 2 above.

2. a. It is felt that paragraph 3 c of COMNAVFE Plan should provide for SCAJAP arranging with CG USAFIK for loading administrative, medical and security personnel and necessary supplies aboard SCAJAP shipping which may be diverted to Korea while at sea.

b. Since it is planned that CG USAFIK will provide personnel and material aboard SCAJAP shipping diverted, it is felt that paragraph 4 of COMNAVFE Plan should not provide for dispatching such personnel and material to Korea unless required.

c. Reference paragraph 4 b (4) e of 8th Army Plan, it is felt that nurses should be included among the medical personnel aboard SCAJAP vessels due to the large number of female evacuees.

3. It is requested that letter approving 8th Army Plan emphasize that approval of plan does not include authority to stock supplies over and above presently authorized supply levels. Further, that in case it is necessary to increase authorized supply levels in order to be prepared to execute GUNSHOT it is requested that the 8th Army make immediate request for such authorization.

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Proposed Revision of Basic Outlining Plan for "GUNSHOT" Operations and Supporting Plans of COMNAVFE, CG FEAF and CG 8th Army.

1. G-1, by check note subject as above, forwarded revised basic outline plan of GUNSHOT operations and supporting plans of COMNAVFE, CG FEAF and CG 8th Army and proposed check note to C/S to G-4 for concurrence or comment.

2. JPO and G-3, by note 2 to above check note, concurred in revised GUNSHOT and supporting plans except that they felt that "H" hour should be designated in the message placing GUNSHOT into effect and that no color system should be used to indicate the imminence of planned operation.

3. a. Revised GHQ plan provides that CG USAFIK will supply necessary personnel and material to SCAJAP shipping diverted to Korea while at sea (paragraph 4 b (1) c). Therefore, it is felt that paragraph 3 of COMNAVFE Plan should provide for SCAJAP arranging with CG USAFIK for loading administrative, medical and security personnel and necessary supplies aboard SCAJAP shipping which may be diverted to Korea while at sea.

b. Since it is planned that CG USAFIK will provide personnel and material aboard SCAJAP shipping diverted, it is felt that paragraph 4 of COMNAVFE Plan should not provide for dispatching this personnel and material to Korea.

c. Reference paragraph 4 b (4) e of 8th Army Plan, it is felt that nurses should be included among the medical personnel aboard SCAJAP vessels due to the large number of female evacuees.

d. While revised GHQ Plan allows only 100 lbs. of baggage per individual, 8th Army and COMNAVFE Plan allows for a maximum of 1900 and 500 long tons of hold baggage and household effects for Inchon and Pusan, respectively, in case the situation will permit. No objection is foreseen to this provision.

e. Current policy requires GHQ FEC approval before stocking supplies in excess of authorized level. Reference paragraph 4 b (4) n

which requires CG I Corps to maintain stocks of supplies and equipment required during period "H" hour to "H" hour plus 36, Lt. Col. Ashman feels that 8th Army should be advised that approval of their plan does not include approval to stock supplies above presently authorized levels. It is not known whether I Corps units are presently authorized sufficient supplies for the first 36 hours of GUNSHOT operation. In any event, it is believed that I Corps units should be authorized sufficient supplies for the first 36 hours of planned operation since it is expected that 36 hours will be required to move in additional supplies.

4. Proposed check note to G-2 that G-4 concurs in JPO and G-3's comments and outlines the additional changes referred to above.
5. The interests of USAFIK have been considered. This action does affect the Korean area, and they are provided for.
6. Within established policy.
7. Action completed on G-4 journal number 50891.

1. JPO and G-3 concur in the revised "GUNSHOT" and supporting plans except for details set forth in the following paragraphs.

2. Inasmuch as a message must be dispatched to subordinate commands to place "GUNSHOT" into effect, it is considered that "H" hour should be designated in that message. This designation could be accomplished by stating that "H" hour is the time of origin of the message or, if desirable, "H" hour could be designated as a time subsequent to the hour of dispatch to provide for the time required on the receiving end to process the incoming message. It does not appear that there is any advantage in specifying "H" hour in advance as the hour of dispatch of the implementing message, and should it be desired to specify a different "H" hour, confusion would result. It is recommended therefore:

a. That par 4, draft ltr, subject: "Revision of Basic Outline Plan for Evacuation, etc., " (Tab H) be revised to substitute the words "who will designate 'H' hour" for "will designate hour of dispatch as 'H' hour."

b. That par 1 c of "GUNSHOT" basic outline plan (Tab H) be revised to eliminate the words "by CINCFE."

3. The advisability of using a color system of imminence for "GUNSHOT" operations is questionable. It will be noted that "GUNSHOT" is a plan to "provide for the evacuation of dependents and U.S. female civilians from Korea to Japan as a matter of urgency with little or no advance warning." Should the time exist that is indicated by the color system, it is probable that a revised plan would be substituted that would involve less handling and more convenience to evacuees, such as diversion of troop transports to move personnel directly from Korea to the United States. No other existing operational plans of FEC utilize a color system, although such plans are designed to meet similar-type emergencies. The color system specified in the SOP for air defense is designed to permit broadcast over an air warning system, and is not believed applicable to "GUNSHOT." It is believed that a warning message stating the degree of imminence could be dispatched as easily as a message giving a color designation. It is recommended therefore, that the color system for designating imminence be omitted from "GUNSHOT."

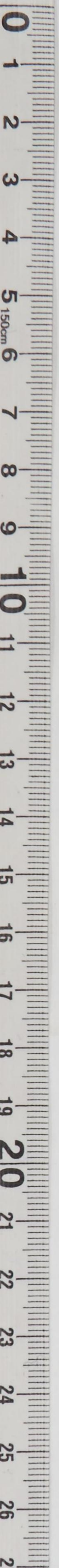

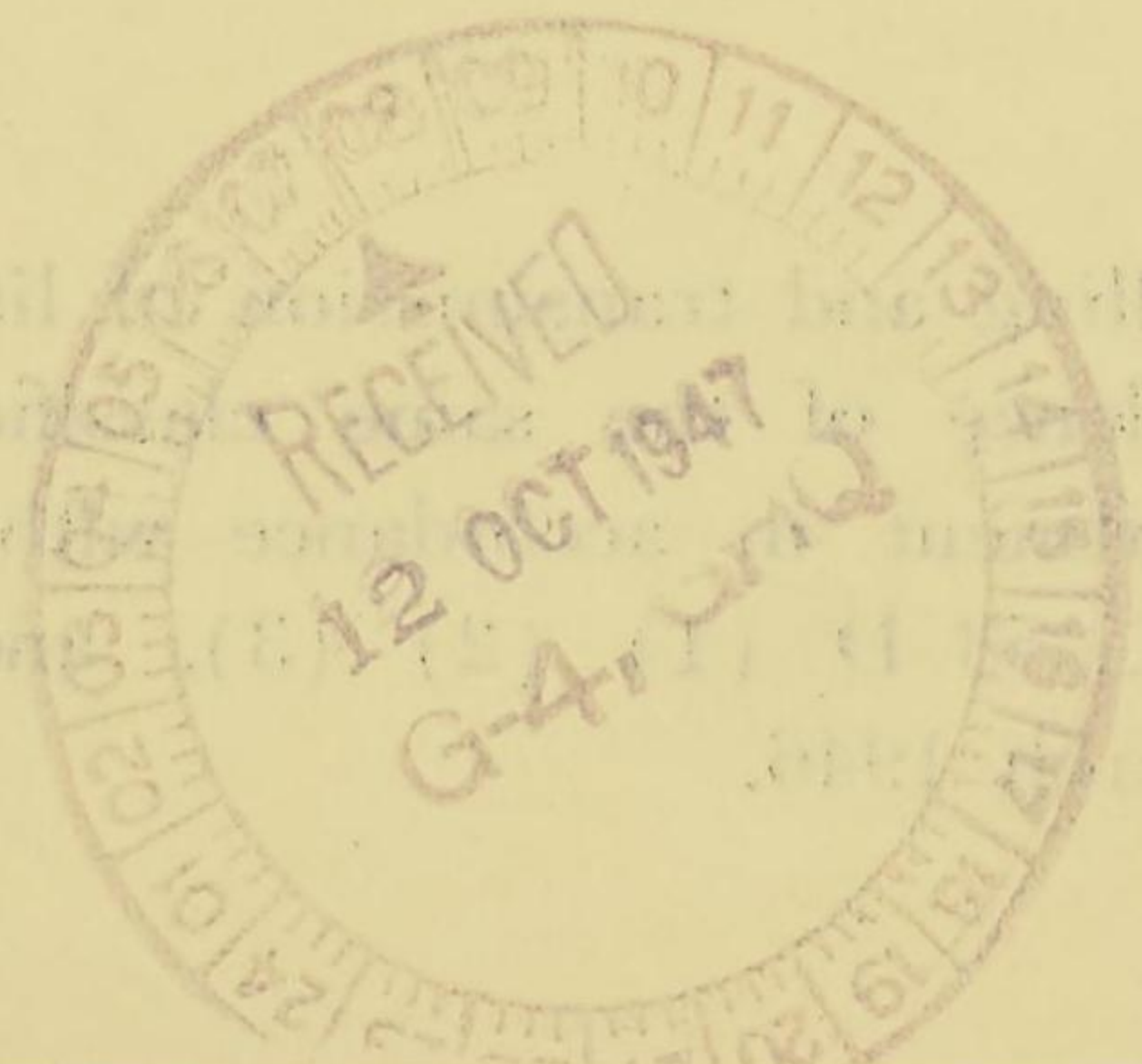
