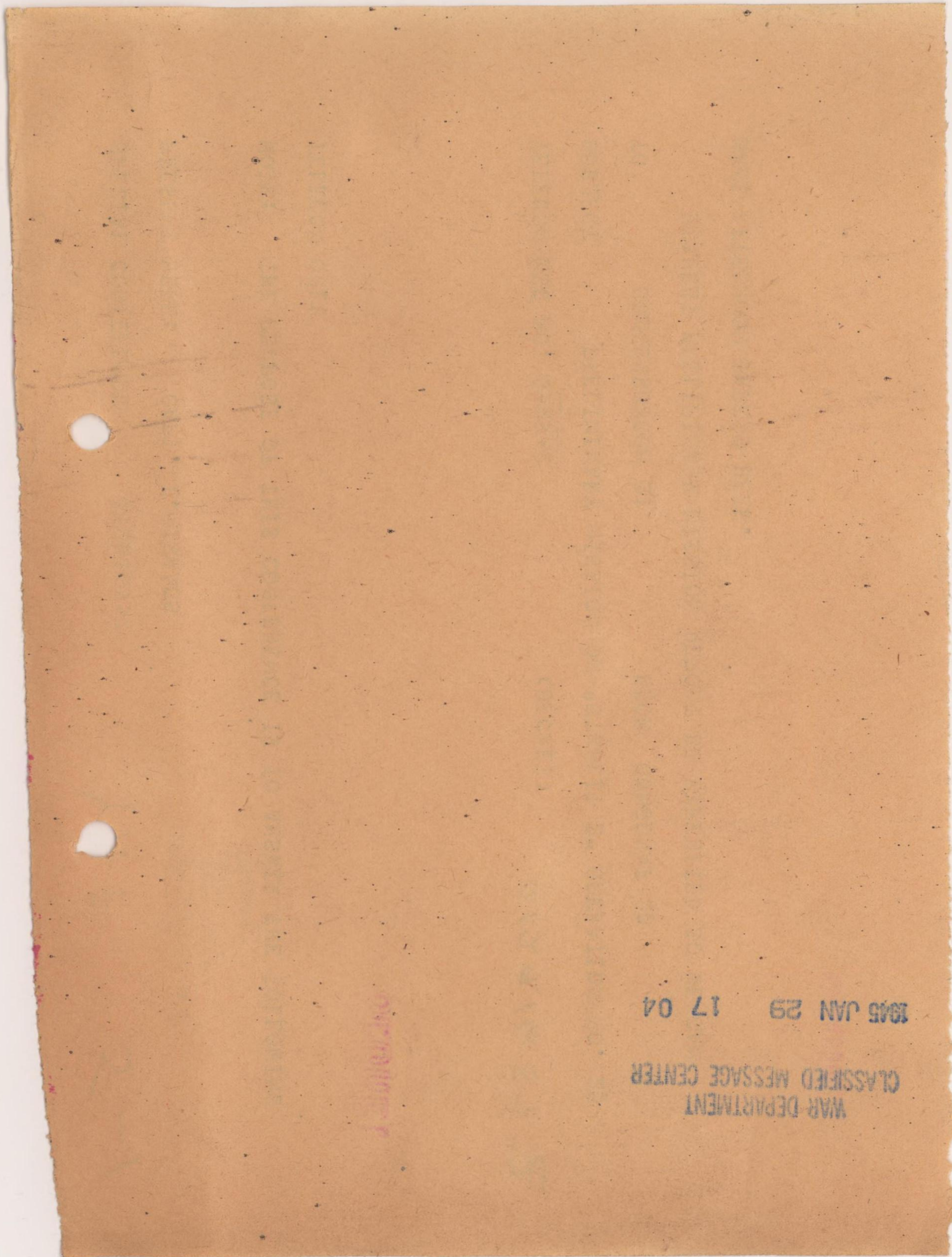

(1) Fighter opposition: Three or four single radial engine fighters believed to be zekes or oscars encountered over target. One observed at 5 o'clock level, appeared to be clocking speed and altitude of formation. Passes were made at three aircraft but E/A broke away at 700 - 1000 yards without firing. Immediately afterward 3 white phosphorus bursts were observed, one 1000 ft below and behind and two from 2000 - 3000 ft above formation. Bursts were 60 ft in diameter with streamers.

(2) Flak: Meager to moderate, inaccurate to accurate. Black bursts generally level and ahead. Groups came in at about 23,000 - 26,000 ft altitude and observed predicted concentrations. Lower element of each squadron seemed to receive burnt of flak. One A/C slightly damaged. Second group over encountered "Balls of Fire," flak concentrations generally white about 500 ft in diameter, about 40 bursts perhaps phosphorus projectiles.

(3) A/C lost or in distress: None.

(4) A/C seriously damaged or crashed upon return: None.

(5) A/C battle damage: 1 A/C -- ready in 3 days.

(6) Observations: None.

(7) Results of bombing: About 72 percent of bomb bursts are recorded on the strike photos. 21 percent of those photographed fell within the briefed target area and nine percent fell within 1000 ft of the main point of impact. Strike photos indicated damage only to the runways. Fires visible from unidentified installation.

(8) Comments or suggestions: None.

(9) Narrative: Take off under poor local weather and assembly was difficult no enemy claims although several aggressive passes were made.
