 let your D. W. Townsend get the amount
 of two pieces damaged Linens which I
 paid Adee Simpson for they were left
 in the Cellar and was to have been
 deducted from my bill but forgotten
 they were bot 4th 23rd No 2. 2 pieces 25 Yds
 I wanted to \$7.75/100 ~~but~~ the
 bill let E. G. Haile copy your bill in a
 letter to me. He will send the Yarn with
 some ^{other} goods to me by so doing you will
 very much oblige your friend
