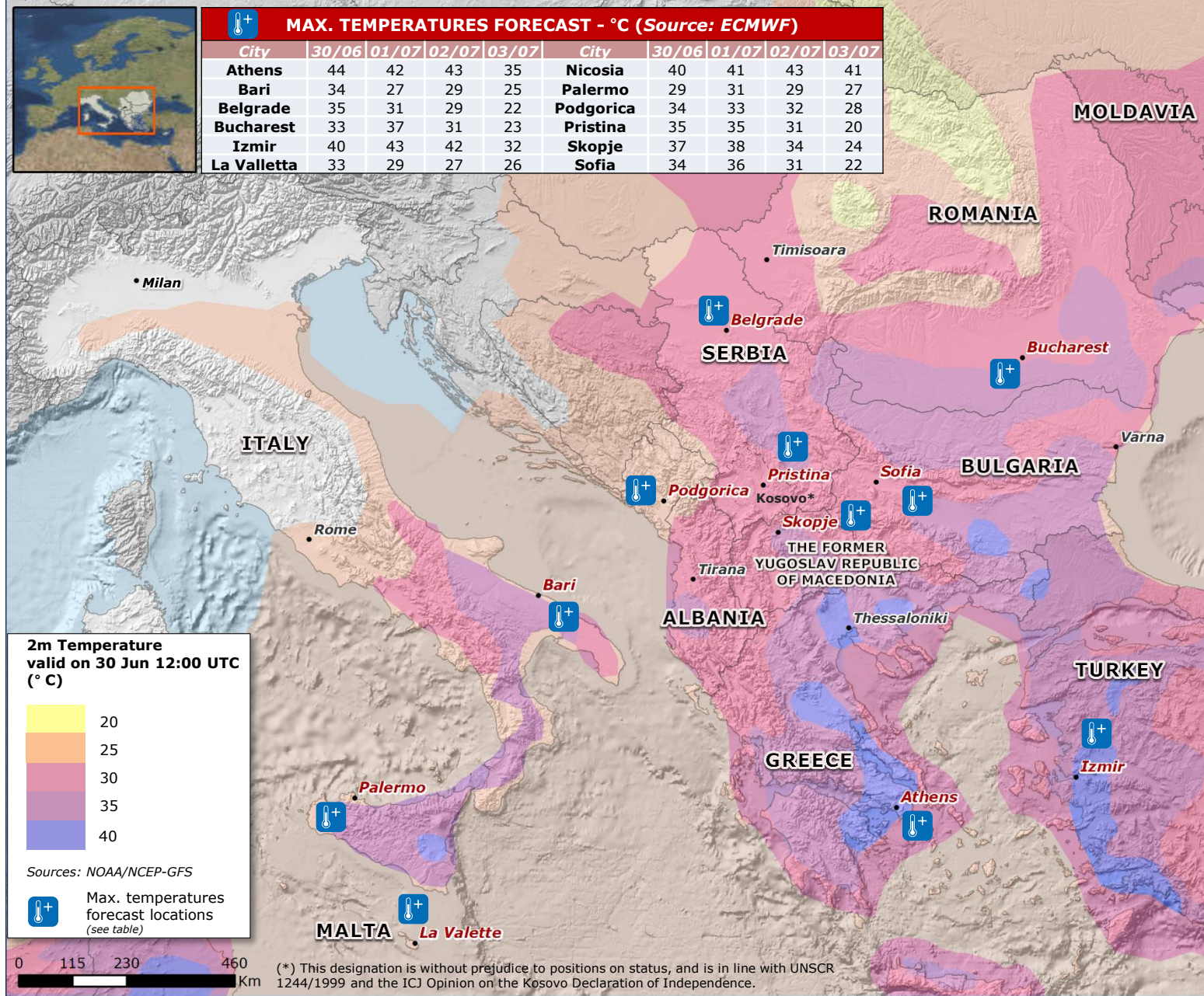

Weather Forecast (30 June-2 July)

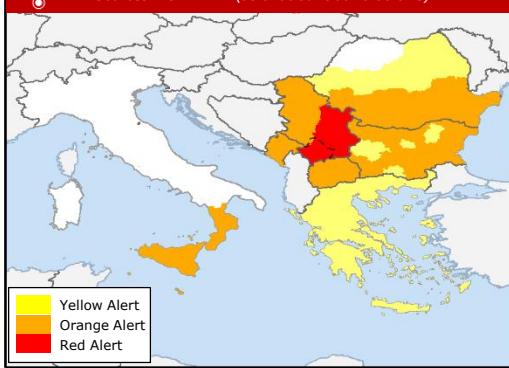
- The current heat wave conditions over southeastern Europe will keep prevailing for the next 48 hours resulting in very high temperatures locally.
- Indicative temperature values: Over Athens maximum temperatures reaching 44°C (30 June) to 42°C (1 July) while over Nicosia 40°C (30 June) to 41°C (1 July).
- Temperatures are forecasted to start cooling down gradually from Sunday (2 July) onwards from western to eastern parts.

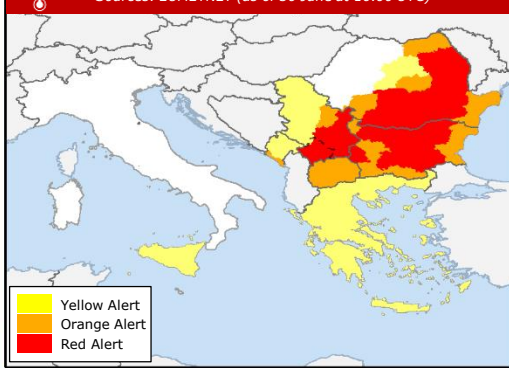
METEOALARM FOR HIGH TEMPERATURES 30 JUNE
