MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

THROUGH: Central Liaison Office, Tokyo

SUBJECT: Gold, Silver and Platinum Family Metals for Domestic Consumption in the First Quarter of 1948

1. Reference is made to the following:

a. C.L.O. No. 7142(LO 3113-FI/FF), 10 September 1947, subject, "Additional Application for Permission to Use Precious Metals in the Fourth Quarter of 1947."

b. C.L.O. No. 8218(LO 3755-FI/FF), 21 October 1947, subject, "Application for Permission to Use Precious Metals for Domestic Consumption in the First Quarter of 1948."

c. Memorandum for Japanese Government, file AG 410.2 (1 Mar 47) CPC/GP, SCAPIN 3312-A, 1 March 1947, subject, "Processing of Precious Metals," from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

d. Memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 410.2 (12 Nov 47) CPC/GP, SCAPIN 1817, 12 November 1947, subject, "Application for Permission to Extend Period of Domestic Consumption of Precious Metals in the Second Quarter of 1947," from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

2. Allocations of precious metals for use in the First Quarter of 1948, are approved as follows:

All silver, gold, rhodium and iridosmine will be obtained from stocks in the possession of the Japanese Government. 22866.5 grams of platinum and 562.2 grams of palladium will be obtained from stocks in the possession of the Japanese Government. Included in the platinum figure is the amount of 3,126.22 grams referred to in paragraph 4, reference 1d above.

b. 1550.8 grams of platinum and 132.6 grams of palladium will be released to authorized representatives of the Ministry of Finance from the Eighth Army Vaults of the Bank of Japan, Tokyo.

c. At the time the precious metals are released from custody of General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers under the authority of paragraph 5b above, the Japanese Government will deposit with the Custodian, Eighth Army Vaults, Bank of Japan, Tokyo, 145,355.2 grams of silver. This silver will be in the form of bars of mint or near mint fineness.

6. The Japanese Government is directed to submit monthly reports to include the following information for each of the firms named in paragraphs 2a, 2b, 2c, 2d, 2e, 2f and 3 above.

a. Silver, gold, platinum, rhodium, iridium, palladium, iridosmine; silver and gold liquid, dust and foil on hand, as of the first day of the month;

b. Silver, gold, platinum, rhodium, iridium, palladium, iridosmine; silver and gold liquid, dust and foil received during the month;

c. Silver, gold, platinum, rhodium, iridium, palladium, iridosmine; silver and gold liquid, dust and foil used during the month;

e. Products manufactured and disposition of same.

7. Reports will be submitted in quadruplicate not later than the nineteenth day of the month following that covered by the report. These reports will include data pertaining to the Ministry of Welfare and the Ministry of Commerce, Utilitarian Merchandise Section, Japanese Government.

UNAUTHORIZED TRANSACTIONS IN PRECIOUS METALS

1. Reference:

SCAP Memorandum to the Imperial Japanese Government, file AG 130 (22 Sep 45) ESS, 22 September 1945, subject: "Control of Financial Transactions".

2. Numerous instances have come to the attention of General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers wherein Japanese concerns and individuals are reported to be conducting transactions in precious metals in violation of SCAP Memorandum for the Imperial Japanese Government, file AG 130 (22 Sep 45) ESS, subject: "Control of Financial Transactions", and ordinances of the Imperial Japanese Government issued in compliance with that directive.

3. The procedure of advising the Imperial Japanese Government to initiate action involves a considerable lapse of time before an investigation is made, thus allowing the suspected dealer to dispose of the metal.

4. The Commanding Generals of all corps and bases and the General Officer Commanding, British Commonwealth Occupation Forces will:

a. Take immediate action upon receipt of information from any source concerning such illegal transactions and seize any precious metals that may be found.

b. In accordance with established procedure, cause such metal to be delivered to the U. S. Army Custodian of the Imperial Japanese Mint, Osaka or the Bank of Japan, Tokyo, for impoundage.

c. Report to this headquarters any precious metal found with the following additional information:

- (1) Name and address of violator.
- (2) Date and location of violation.
- (3) Approximate quantities of precious metals seized.
- (4) Disposition of seized metals.
- (5) Source of information which led to seizure.

5. A follow-up report will be submitted indicating the action taken against the violator.

The Imperial Japanese Government will be advised to furnish English Language copies of authorizations to users as soon as practicable.
