## Appreciation

I take this opportunity to say to all my many customers that I greatly appreciate their generous expressions of satisfaction at Treholme quality and service given them the past year. My special effort to provide better plants of the world's best irises for less than they can be secured anywhere else has evidently been appreciated. A large part, in fact my greatest remuneration, has come through serving to the best of my time and means, those who have so generously favored me with their business. If there are those who were not entirely satisfied, it was because I did not know it. It is an established Treholme policy that **a deal is never closed until all reasonable customers are satisfied.** Let me know how previous orders pleased you if you have not already done so.

## New Introductions

In accordance with my policy of adding each year the best introductions from this and other countries, I am offering varieties that have not been previously sold or widely distributed. In selecting the new varieties which are offered, I have paid particular attention that they be of new or distinct colorings as well as to the other qualities that are required to make good garden irises, including: Vigorous with good growing habits, strong well-branched stalks, free-flowering over a long period, and with a good firm texture which can be relied upon to withstand the most trying weather conditions. There are also some very fine exhibition varieties offered for the first time in this country. They are characterized by their wonderful color, size, form, branching and distinctive qualities that place them well at the top of the list for exhibition purposes as well as for specimen clumps or for garden use.

I am not listing for sale all of the varieties which have been introduced. You will find listed practically all of the new varieties thought to be worth having or that are improvements on other varieties. Practically all of the new varieties are carefully observed annually and those thought to be especially meritorious are secured for trial and observation. If you do not find a new introduction in this list you can rest assured that it is either not worth while, or is still under observation. Or if you do not find all of the older varieties previously listed you will know that they have been superseded in my estimation and discarded.

I have more than 500 new varieties under observation in addition to Treholme seedlings, many of which will be added to this list as soon as they have satisfied me that they are worthy of distribution and availability of stock permits. If you are interested in a variety which does not appear in the price list, write me about it. I probably can supply you or tell you where the variety may be secured to best advantage.

## The 1933 Supplement

I have endeavored to give in the supplement to my "Iris Lover's Guide" which is issued separately, an accurate yet practical description of these new varieties with tentative garden and exhibition ratings, as I have observed them since their introduction. This evaluation, subject to modification as they demonstrate their good qualities or faults, if any, is my comparative estimation of their worth. I have been requested many times to recommend the best varieties in the different color groups for exhibition and garden purposes. Obviously the garden and exhibition rating indicates my selections automatically. I should emphasize that price or novelty has not influenced me in the least in making the ratings. I have given special consideration to the growing habits and hardiness of the different varieties. Color has been an important consideration as have also the factors of average height, branching, size, form, poise, effectiveness, freedom of bloom, substance and distinctive qualities. ## TALL AND INTERMEDIATE BEARDED IRIS

(May and June Flowering)

This group may be said to be the most satisfactory and easily grown group of plants now in cultivation. They are unexcelled for brilliancy of color, very hardy and free flowering and excellent for cutting. In the effort to have bloom in the garden throughout the year, May-flowering Irises should not be overlooked. During late seasons this group provides the only memorial Day flower to be found in quantity. They are most useful and dependable, being of medium height and early to bloom. They are especially useful as borders for tulip beds. The intermediate varieties are from 18 to 28 inches in height being taller than the Dwarfs, bloom ten days later and a week or more before the Tall Bearded varieties. They are, therefore, intermediate in size as well as in height and, for the most part, in season of bloom. The Tall Bearded varieties begin blooming in late May and bloom for six weeks most seasons. They vary in height from 30 inches up to 50 inches or more.

## JAPANESE IRISES

For a richly colored display in the border or for specimen clumps, Japanese Irises are highly recommended. They bloom after the bearded iris and continue for several weeks. They are excellent for cutting and for garden decoration. The colors are very striking, being white, blue, purple, red and combinations of these colors, beautifully harmonized. While they require somewhat different treatment than the bearded varieties, yet they are hardy and most satisfactory. They require a sunny location and a rich soil with plenty of moisture, but where water does not stand. The addition of a little peat moss to clay soils will be very beneficial. Since they do best in slightly acid soil, no lime should be used; in locations where there is danger from heaving during freezing weather a light mulch may be applied the first season after planting.

I have been growing a large number of the best named varieties of Japanese iris for many years in my attempts to classify and rate, both for exhibition and landscape purposes. While this work is progressing I have accumulated a surplus of many varieties that I can now offer at unusual prices. They are first class plants in every respect and up to the Treholme Standard and Quality.

Delivery will begin about September 15th, or earlier if desired. The danger from dry weather has usually passed by that date and they can be planted without loss. Japanese Iris are quite hardy. They do not stand dry weather at planting time, however, as well as the bearded varieties. If weather is dry when planted they should be watered frequently until established.

## DUTCH AND SPANISH IRISES

For several years I have been growing Dutch and Spanish Iris. The growing of these types has given me great pleasure. They come in pure white and all shades from white, through red, yellow, blue and to deep purple, some being spotted, splashed and mottled most artistically, in a wonderful harmony of colors. They are excellent for cutting. If cut in the bud they will keep for a long time in water. They blend splendidly with other flowers. For best effect they should be planted in clumps of one or two dozen, or better, in rows for ease of cultivation which they should have at frequent intervals. They are well adapted for planting in the hardy border, and for forcing in the green house or in pots.

They are very hardy when given proper treatment. They do not do well in a hot, dry situation. They thrive in cool, moist soil that is well enriched with compost or well rotted manure. Planted in September they will bloom the next spring soon after the narcissus season.

I lift the bulbs when mature, which is usually before the tops begin to die down in late July. As soon as dug, they are spread out in trays in a dry location where the air passes over them freely. I plant them back again in early October, setting 6 inches apart and about 4 to 5 inches deep, depending upon the size; the larger bulbs being planted five inches deep in light, sandy soil. They are planted about four inches deep if the soil is clay-loam. The soil is pressed firmly over them. A loose mulch will be helpful if the soil is inclined to heave them out in winter.

I have confidence that these irises will be much more generally grown in a few years. A little patience in learning their habits and requirements of soil and climate will be well rewarded. I have heard some complaints that a few bulbs are lost each year. My losses, however, are no greater than with tulips, gladioli or other bulbs.

The following varieties are among the best that are now in existence. The prices are for the large, first size blooming bulbs. The size of the bulbs vary somewhat according to the variety. Plant a few well chosen varieties under favorable conditions and they will be a source of much enjoyment.

of "New, Rare and Good Old Irises," an Iris Lover's Guide and descriptive catalogue. If you are a customer of mine and have purchased Iris during the past year you have already or will soon receive a copy, to others the price is 25 cents. It will be sent free with all orders. If a copy is purchased at 25 cents and an order amounting to \$2.50 is placed later, any 50 cent Iris may be selected free. Garden clubs or other groups may order together and obtain 10 copies for \$2.00.

## Selecting Varieties

It is as a rule best to select several roots of a variety rather than one root of each, whether the object be to produce specimen stalks or for the effect on the landscape. The effect is more pleasing when planted in clumps of 3 or 5, each variety or group of varieties being kept separate and so arranged that the colors harmonize. Almost any color effect desired may be secured by careful selection. Varieties that will harmonize with most any other flower or surrounding may be secured. It is possible to secure satisfactory results for landscape purposes by selecting from the moderately priced varieties. If the best results are desired, it is well to keep in mind that as a rule the higher priced varieties are improvements over the cheaper ones in one or more respects. As a rule the size, color, form, substance, vigor, branching, number of bloom and length of flowering period are among the points in which they usually excel.

## Something for the Future

For many years I have been collecting and breeding irises as a hobby. I have had a wonderful time doing it. Thousands of crosses have been made. Some of the seedlings produced have been decided improvements on existing varieties. Many of the special crosses have resulted in some very fine flowers of wonderful form and a substance lasting long in bloom over a long period—on plants that are vigorous, well-branched and free-flowering with distinct and most delightful color combinations. Among them are some gems in the *Pumila* group. During all these years I have introduced only a few varieties, largely because most of them have not approached my standard. On the other hand, some of them are so good that I have registered the names with the American Iris Society, expecting to observe them further and if they continue to measure up so well in comparison with varieties already on the market, I expect to introduce the best of them to the iris loving public at moderate prices as soon as availability of stock permits. To allay the fears of a few enthusiasts who have been much alarmed that I have named these varieties and possibly would introduce or put all of them on the market, but more particularly to emphasize what has been stated many times as a definite policy:

They have been named for my own pleasure and convenience, and only those of outstanding merit will ever be introduced. Only two varieties have been introduced, and both of them, among others still under observation, were recommended for Honorable Mention by accredited judges to the American Iris Society. One of them, "My Maryland," which was awarded an Honorable Mention by the Society in 1930, was recently declared one of the three best varieties introduced and put on the market in 1930, according to information compiled by a breeder and critical judge of iris, from a questionnaire that he sent to prominent iris dealers, breeders and others throughout the United States. I feel sure some of these varieties will be awaited with unusual interest.

## Your Opportunity

I am offering many varieties of irises at unusual prices. It is a rare opportunity for commercial growers and collectors to secure many varieties that are new, scarce and seldom offered for sale. Many varieties will soon be sold out at the prices quoted.

## Quantity Prices

You are urged to compare the prices in this list with the prices of any other grower in this or any other country. Instead of developing extensive or elaborate display gardens, an effort has been made to provide better plants for less money than can be secured anywhere else in the world. This has been made possible be-



cause of a carefully planned system of growing the plants. The purchaser receives the benefit, as the result of this economy is reflected in the unusual prices quoted. Especially is this true when 5 or more plants of a variety, or when 8, 15, 25, 50 or more different varieties can be used. It has been my policy to offer plants at the lowest price possible, commensurate with quality, rather than offer collections in which there might be varieties not desired or even varieties of questionable value, simply because a surplus might be available. I will be glad to help make up collections if desired, provided the following schedules are not sufficient.

The quantity price of any variety is ascertained by reference to the retail price and then from the table obtaining the price in lots of 5 and 25 or more. Another said: "I appreciate your exhibition and garden rating information. Your appraisal of the new ones especially is invaluable. It has saved and made me many dollars."

The 1932 edition contains more than 250 new varieties and omits nearly as many that I consider have been superseded or are no longer needed. If you are a customer of mine and have purchased iris during the past year, you have already received a copy or I will gladly send you one together with the 1933 supplement upon request, to others the price is 25 cents. Do not send coin. Send P. O. Money Order or stamps to avoid possible loss. A copy will be sent free with all orders. If a copy is purchased at 25 cents and an order amounting to \$2.50 is placed later, any 50-cent iris may be selected free.

I have added Japanese, Dutch and Spanish iris this year and have given tentative ratings. Peonies have been added also, with exhibition, garden and commercial ratings given for the first time.
