STOCKS OF LEAF TOBACCO OWNED BY DEALERS AND MANUFACTURERS

APRIL 1, 1938

Stocks of leaf tobacco owned by dealers and manufacturers in the United States and Puerto Rico on April 1, 1938, amounted to 2,432,207,000 pounds, compared with 2,279,113,000 pounds on April 1, 1937, and 2,222,019,000 pounds on January 1, 1938. Total stocks were 153,094,000 pounds higher than a year ago April 1, and 210,188,000 pounds higher than on January 1, 1938. The increase in total stocks during the first quarter of 1938 was considerably higher than the increase during the same period of 1937.

Stocks of flue-cured tobacco were reported as 930,907,000 pounds on April 1, 1938, about 58 million pounds higher than a year ago April 1, and about 138 million pounds lower than on January 1, 1938. The stocks of Type 11 on April 1, 1938, were reported as 402,052,000 pounds; Type 12 as 292,221,000 pounds; Type 13 as 168,950,000 pounds; and Type 14 as 67,684,000 pounds.

Stocks of fire-cured tobacco of all types were reported as 205,289,000 pounds on April 1, 1938, compared with 215,883,000 pounds on April 1, 1937, a decrease of about 10½ million pounds. Virginia Fire-cured, Type 21, stocks were reported as 31,032,000 pounds; Type 22 as 126,560,000 pounds; Type 23 as 45,434,000 pounds; and Type 24 as 2,263,000 pounds.

Due to increased production in 1937 Burley stocks were 81,399,000 pounds higher on April 1, 1938, than they were a year ago April 1. The April 1, 1938, report shows 716,720,000 pounds of Burley. Maryland tobacco, Type 32, stocks were reported as 34,740,000 pounds on April 1, 1938. One Sucker stocks on April 1, 1938, were 39,238,000 pounds; Green River stocks were 27,704,000 pounds; Virginia Sun-cured, 3,204,000 pounds; Eastern Ohio, 338,000 pounds; Perique, 355,000 pounds; Other Miscellaneous Domestic, 369,000 pounds; and foreign-grown cigarette tobacco (Turkish and other), 92,360,000 pounds. The marked increase in One Sucker and Green River stocks from January to April is due to increased production.

APRIL 1 CIGAR LEAF TOBACCO STOCKS

Stocks of American-grown cigar-filler types amounted to 210,296,000 pounds on April 1, 1938, an increase of about 2 million pounds over the stocks of April 1, 1937. Compared with a year ago, Types 41, 44, and 46 are higher, and Types 42, 43, and 45 are lower. Type 41, Pennsylvania Seedleaf, stocks were 112,597,000 pounds on April 1, 1938; Type 42, Gebhardt, 15,949,000 pounds; Type 43, Zimmer, 20,014,000 pounds; Type 44, Dutch, 14,290,000 pounds; Type 45, Georgia and Florida sun-grown, 1,541,000 pounds; and Type 46, Puerto Rican (including that on the Island), 45,905,000 pounds. The detailed report by groups of grades shows about two-fifths of one percent of the total filler type stocks as binder quality; 143,991,000 pounds, or about 68 percent in the C group as strictly filler grades; 52,769,000 pounds, or about 25 percent in the X group as stemming grades; 3,041,000, or about 4 percent in the Y group as ground leaves; and the balance in the S and N groups.

The cigar binder type stocks, some of which are used for wrappers were 6,599,000 pounds lower on April 1, 1938, than they were April 1 a year ago. Total binder type stocks were reported as 150,103,000 pounds on April 1, 1938. Type 51, Connecticut Broadleaf, stocks were reported as 35,396,000 pounds; Type 52, Connecticut Havana Seed, 29,227,000 pounds; Type 53, New York and Pennsylvania Havana Seed, 2,666,000 pounds; Type 54, Southern Wisconsin, 49,593,000 pounds, and Northern Wisconsin, 33,221,000 pounds. The detailed report by groups of grades shows that of the total binder type stocks reported 4,040,000 pounds, or about 3 percent are of wrapper quality; 63,099,000 pounds or about 42 percent, are binders; 3,271,000 pounds, or about 2 percent, are fillers; 78,303,000 pounds, or about 52 percent are X group or stemming grade tobacco; and the balance in the Y, S, and N groups.

Shade-grown wrapper type stocks were reported on April 1, 1938, as 10,752,000 pounds. Connecticut Shade stocks were 7,776,000 pounds, and Georgia and Florida Shade stocks were 2,976,000 pounds. Of the total shade tobacco stocks reported, 9,433,000 pounds are shown in the A group as being of actual wrapper quality.

The foreign-grown cigar-leaf tobacco stocks in the United States on April 1, 1938, consisted of 6,146,000 pounds of Cuba (Havana) tobacco, 1,404,000 pounds of Sumatra and Java, and 2,263,000 pounds of Philippine Islands (Manila) tobacco. The detailed report shows these stocks subdivided into wrappers, fillers, and scrap.

The figures quoted for type totals are the sums of unstemmed and stemmed leaf as reported. For information on American-grown types shown on a farm-sales-weight basis with stemmed leaf converted to unstemmed equivalent, see page 12 of this report.
