### **Learning Objectives**

## Students will gain, reinforce, understand, or learn:

- The importance of citations in expository writing
- Basic research skills (how to find credible sources)
- The knowledge of how a large online community works
- How to collaborate with others worldwide in an online community

### **Resources & Tools**

- <u>How to add references using the</u> <u>source editor</u> (as opposed to VisualEditor)
- <u>Wikipedia:Citing Sources</u> (background information about citations on Wikipedia and what they are used for)

#### **STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS**

- 1. Show students an article that is missing a citation and explain why it is important to have citations. (Make sure to explain that Wikipedia can be a credible source if it has citations).
- 2. Do a brief lecture informing students of what credible or non-credible sources look like, using this <u>link</u>.
- 3. Use <u>CitationHunt</u> to search for articles that need citations.
- 4. Add citation to article.
