
15 Oct 2013: East Asia – Earthquake, Tropical Cyclones, Severe Weather

SITUATION

- NARI made landfall near Da Nang city on 14 Oct as a Typhoon. Heavy rainfall (221mm in 24h) and strong winds caused extended damage in roads and houses. As of 12:00 UTC on 15 Oct, 5 deaths were reported. Prior to landfall, 123 000 people were evacuated, mostly in Da Nang and Quang Nam. provinces. (CCFSC, MONRE, AFP)

 On 15 and 16 Oct, NARI, weakened to a Tropical Depression, is expected to move over southern Lao PDR and eastern Thailand, affecting these areas with heavy rainfall. (GDACS)
 At 06:00 UTC on 15 Oct, WIPHA
- At 06:00 UTC on 15 Oct, WIPHA was a Typhoon (max. sust. winds of 148 km/h) and its centre was located 900 km SW of Tokyo (Japan). It is forecasted to move NE, weakening slightly, and possibly passing close/over SE Honshu, near Tokyo, late on 15 Oct (UTC).
 Strong winds and heavy rains might
- affect parts of SE Honshu on 15-16 Oct. JRC calculations indicate a possible storm surge of the order of 0.8 m in the coastal area near Asahi, east of Tokyo (Japan) for 15 Oct evening (UTC) (GDACS, JMA, AFP)
- At 00:12 UTC on 15 Oct, an earthquake of magnitude 7.1M at a depth of 20 km hit Bohol island (Central Visayas). (GDACS)

- USGS-PAGER indicates shaking of up to "Severe" for 185 000 people. No significant tsunami risk was posed by this earthquake; JRC calculations indicate a max. height of around 0.3m in Guindulman.
