

b. In addition to the above interviews, a conference of all mayors and village masters was held on 7 July in connection with food delivery. At this time the role transportation control plays in the food program was emphasized and locally increased enforcement urged. Similar conferences were held with the Chief of the Agriculture & Forestry Department and Chiefs of the Food, Agriculture and Farm Land Sections.

c. A total of 957 violations were discovered by police during July and 89 persons brought to trial for violation of transportation control regulations. Foodstuffs, charcoal and firewood were the only commodities subject to consistent attempts at violation.


