

**Climate & Environment is one of** Wikimedia UK's three strategic themes for 2022-2025. It recognises the accelerating climate crisis and Wikimedia's vital role in providing up-to-date, accurate and unbiased information about the impact of climate breakdown on our planet and people, as well as potential actions, mitigations and adaptations.

#### Wikimedia's climate coverage could be better

The number of editors working on climate is small, with little expert input. Coverage of issues impacting the global majority is poor, and mis/disinformation is a concern on non-English wikis. Greenwashing is an issue, compounded by a lack of open data from climate NGOs.



#### Wikimedia Visiting Fellow at the Global Systems Institute

In October 2022, Wikimedia UK and the University of Exeter launched a new partnership, with the appointment of a Wikimedia Visiting Fellow at the **Global Systems Institute. The partnership came** about due to the work and connections of Wikipedia's dedicated - if small - community of editors contributing to climate topics, the support of the GSI's management team, and funding from an external foundation.

# Tackling misinformation

Greenhouse gas emissions present a broader threat through sea temperature rise and sea level rise, resulting in widespread coral bleaching and loss of coral cover.<sup>[160]</sup> though Ocean acidification also affects corals by decreasing calcification rates and increasing dissolution rates, although corals can adapt their calcifying fluids to changes in seawater pH and carbonate levels and are not directly threatened by ocean acidification to mitigate the impact.<sup>[161]</sup> <sup>[162]</sup> Volcanic and manmade aerosol pollution can modulate regional sea surface temperatures.<sup>[163]</sup>

## Improving coverage of key concepts

- Collaborating with an external organisation to develop the 'Net Zero' article, to distinguish concept from 'Carbon Neutrality.
- Clarifying these differences helps people understand the strategies, goals, and implications associated with each term, which is crucial for organisations making decisions and setting goals related to climate change.
- Clear information helps ensure actions are based on an understanding of the different strategies and their impacts.



#### **External advocacy**

- Encouraging researchers to think about using Wikipedia as an impactful communications platform for their work.
- State of Global Tipping Points report - to be launched at COP28.
- Sharing research on Wikipedia makes it available to millions.

### **Partnership working**

In collaboration with Wikimedia New York City, Earth Alliance and influencer @depthsofwikipedia we organised a climate change editathon in NYC. Key themes were 1) How we eat, 2) How we move, 3) How we live, 4) What inspires us. The event was attended by new and established editors and resulted in a positive, collaborative space with good quality edits made to articles including the impact of flying first or business class; cocoa production in Ghana; and fishing economy concerns in the Revillagigedo Islands.



#### Key achievements by July 2023

- 8 editathon events
- 70+ editors trained
- 248 articles edited
- 7 million page views

## Challenges and key observations

- Securing a work visa!
- Academic timetables and ongoing strikes
- Expert availability and involvement
- Retaining interest in editathons
- No metric for quality of edits

**Next steps: Securing** funding for a second year of the residency, and expanding the work to Wikipedia en español.
