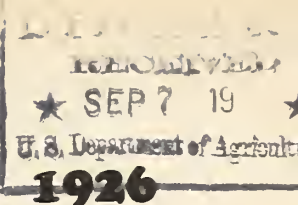

Iris, Peonies and Hardy Plants

RATINGS—The figures given before each variety are the ratings given by the Jury appointed by the American Iris Society in 1921. Those not rated are varieties that have been originated since the ratings were given by the American Iris Society.

PRICES—The prices quoted are for single rhizomes. Six of one variety may be had at the price of five. Cash should be sent with the order, by check or money order preferred.

PLANTING—The best time for transplanting Irises is after they are through flowering in July or August. Prices quoted in this catalogue are for shipment at that time. The varieties offered are perfectly hardy and will bloom anywhere if given some sun. Do not plant too deep. The best method is just level with the ground. A light covering of leaves or straw, or rough trash is beneficial the first winter, especially if they are planted late in the Fall, to prevent the frost from throwing them out of the ground. After the first year they require no attention excepting to divide them every three or four years. Avoid manure and over-watering. Bone meal is an aid to flowering.

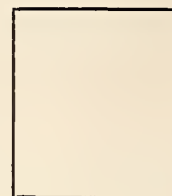
