# "Fichier national d'entités" : context & objectives

## Context

- Technological environment (with LOD, ...)
- A fundamental change in envisioning bibliographic data – from records to interconnected entities

## Objectives

- A joint initiative from Abes and BnF to build a new service to libraries and beyond (GLAMs)
- A shared platform for collaboratively creating and maintaining reference data about entities (persons, corporate bodies, places, concepts, creative works, ...)

# A proof of concept using Wikibase

## 2017-2018

- Exploring the ground for the scope of the “Fichier national d’Entités”
- Benchmark of other similar initiatives
- Strong interest in Wikibase as the FNE’s technical backbone

## 2019

- Building a proof of concept with real data from BnF and Abes

# First findings

- No major obstacle to ingest library data according to a specific ontology
- Conformation that Wikibase offers built-in features that could be used as the bases for the technical infrastructure of FNE
- Gap between the specific needs of our institutions and the solutions offered by Wikibase (e.g.: search, roles, constraints, data publication in relation to data provac policies...)
- Necessity to be part of a community sharing the same concerns
