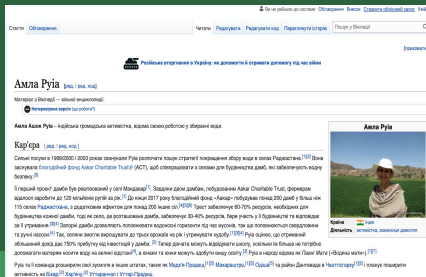

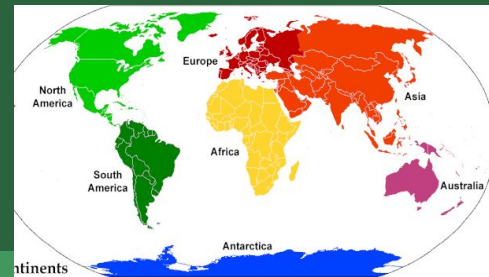

We saw over 900 participants joining several community events across the continent.

9000+
Wikipedia Articles

Participants contributed over 9000+ wikipedia articles on diverse language wikipedias. There were other significant contributions including 5000 Wikidata items, and 7000 Wikimedia Commons uploads etc.

What is new this year?

Translation Drive

- **Writing contests** was not reaching many of the missing languages
- **Focus on translating** about the UDHR which is in 550 languages and other international foundational texts
- **Only inviting smaller language Wikipedias** with short or missing articles
- **Focused on using the Content Translation Tools**

Rapid Grant Timelines, Criteria and Support

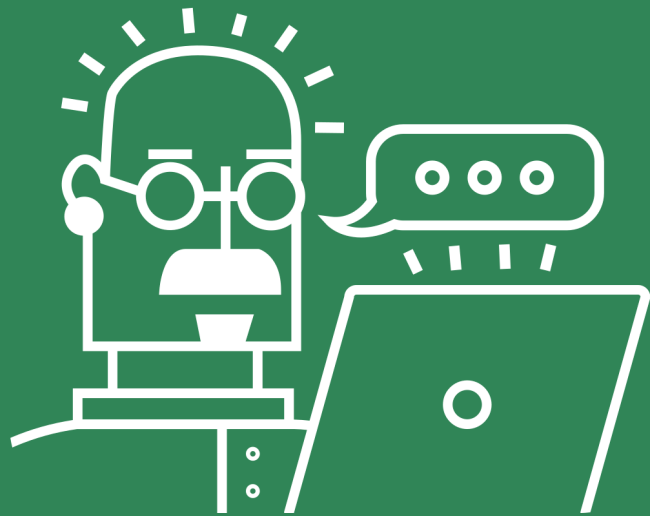
- One (1) grant application per country or user group
 - Communicate with your community to identify or collaborate with interested groups or persons
 - Mobilize and collaborate on application for submission
 - Register your interest to organize local activities for the campaign on the [meta page](#)
 - Let your regional coordinator know you have applied for a rapid grant or write us via campaigns@wikimedia.org to follow up on the application

Rapid Grant Timelines, Criteria and Support

- **Only cycle 5 is open before campaign start in May**
 - Application deadline on 1 April
 - Review time from 2 April - 7 May
 - Decision announced from 11 May
 - Processing and Disbursement from 12 - 26 May
