PLANTING:—Ornamentals, Evergreens, Deciduous Trees, Shrubs, Perennial Plants, etc, in the Puget Suond country, may be planted at any time in the fall after the rainy season commences, and continued through the winter till May 1st.

But when possible transplant in the fall, it is much easier for plants to take hold of the new soil and plants will be more vigorous and easier to take care of the first year.

CARE IN PLANTING—Dig the soil about 2 feet deep, if any sod or leaves are at hand, use a good layer of them at the bottom of hole, firm the soil around the roots when planting; water plants thoroughly after planting.
