Friend Hunt

I this day made a settlement of the plough concern with M. Kendy for agreeable to your request. After Mr Kendy was gone I discovered a receipt of the Purser's for \$8.93 given May 30. 1823, which on a reference to the account as made and you will readily discover was not there charged. I do not wish the money refunded but am willing to receive it out of the money to be paid in on the notes now in my hands.

I have given you this early notice of the mistake that it may be arranged between you & the Purser's and hope the above statement together with a reference to the account & current will be satisfactory.
