d. Details of serious violations of election laws or SCAPINS, including all violations directly affecting elected candidates or elective public officials: None

e. Any unusual incidents: Election postponed until 22 August 1949 due to flood conditions in Saga Prefecture. This report does not contain results of Ogi-gun.

f. Remarks:

- (1) Election in Ogi-gun postponed until 27 August 1949 due to flood damage.
- (2) Results of last election unavailable due to burning of Prefectural office building in February 1949.
- (3) 44 villages did not vote due to uncontested candidates running. The total possible voters in areas where candidacy was contested amounted to 93,905 of which 75,903 voted, (38,356 men and 37,547 women) for a percentage of 80.08% (86% men and 76.1% women)

2. General account of election.

a. Little interest was shown on the part of the electorate in this prefecture. This lack of interest was due to people thinking that the main part of the work of the farmland commission had already been accomplished and that its future work was relatively unimportant.

b. The small number of candidates was due to:

- (1) Few persons feeling themselves qualified to handle difficult local problems.
- (2) Disinclination to place themselves in a position to be the target for communist attacks.
- (3) Candidates were pre-selected by local bosses or influential groups. Persons not so selected realized it was futile to enter the campaign.

3. Publicity given the election.

a. Posters were posted on bulletin boards through out the prefecture.

b. Leaflets were distributed.

c. A series of meetings were held by the Election Administration Committees.

4. There were no cases of prominent campaign issues or any significant political strategy.

5. No serious violations of election laws have been reported to this headquarters.

1. Reference: Letter AGMGL 091, Headquarters Eighth Army, Subject "Reports Required for Agricultural Land Commissions Election", dated 7 July 1948.

2. A list of party-affiliated successful candidates is attached hereto in compliance with paragraph 3 e, above reference.

3. Elections were performed in 204 districts out of a total of 265 districts in the prefecture. In the remaining 61 districts the number of candidates equalled the number of positions to be filled; therefore no elections were necessary.

4. Positions to be filled totalled 2641. The number of candidates competing for these positions totalled 3206; 100 of whom were party-affiliated. Communist party candidates totalled 61, of whom 28 were successful. 32 Socialist party candidates were successful. 2560 of the successful candidates were independents. Total number of persons elected is 2627; leaving a total of 14 vacancies to be considered by the Prefectural Commission.

ings with the citizens in their respective districts. Press releases also appeared in the newspapers of the prefecture. However, the only real information and knowledge concerning the election and its purpose and significance was disseminated to the public through the District Offices. The only billboard posters used were those erected by the Communist Party. Nothing unusual or extraordinary appeared on these posters.

7. Campaign activities were limited to ten known public speeches; all of which were delivered by Communist Party members to small gatherings. No prominent campaign issues were raised and no other political party was actively engaged in campaigning.

8. No violations of election laws have been detected or reported and no unusual incidents occurred during the election.

9. The extent of surveillance by this team was by liaison with the Prefectural Local Affairs Section and discussions with local officials throughout the prefecture.

b. Although Eighty two percent (82%) of the eligible voters cast ballots in this Prefecture there were no broad issues prominent in the campaign. The candidates bearing the designation of non-partisan were mostly strongly conservative. Personalities were the chief factor in the campaign. In general, the campaigning of the candidates was carried out with a minimum of conflict or energy. The high voting rate was apparently due to the fact that intensive informational and publicity activities had been carried out in preparation for the election. These included numerous pamphlets, leaflets, posters, constant radio broadcasts, newspaper publicity, and lecture and discussion meetings.

c. No violations of election laws were noted in this Prefecture.

Pursuant to instructions contained in letter, Hqs Eighth Army, dtd 7 July 1949, subj: "Report Required for Agricultural Land Commissions Election", the following report is submitted:

(1) Names of successful candidates, location of committee to which elected and name of supporting political party of each successful candidate. (See Incl #1)

(2) a. Election was orderly and no irregularity was noted or reported. The interest on the part of average farmers was significant beyond general expectation. 84.3% votes cast were land-owners, 82.5% were owner-operators and lowest being the tenants with 78.5% an average of 81.6% in all.

b. The official election returns in the prefecture are as follows:

Independent	1395 elected,	119,855 popular votes.
Democratic Liberal	171 elected,	17,623 popular votes.
Social Democratic	117 elected,	8,652 popular votes.
Democrats	35 elected,	2,669 popular votes.
Minors	21 elected,	2,592 popular votes.
Communist	19 elected,	4,772 popular votes.

Total of 2,136 candidates participated in the election.

c. Out of a total of 1,757 newly elected commissioners in this Prefecture, 975 were installed in office without opposition at 51 cities, towns and villages (3 cities, 8 towns and 50 villages - See Incl #2). 632 commissioners of the above total were re-elected.

d. Farmers in general had an opinion that the mission of the Agricultural Land Commissions was almost completed, therefore it was alleged that they were not interested in the election. However, the outcome of voting was satisfactory.

e. Publicity given the election:

- 1) Radio - Two broadcasts on the election were released over the local hour.
- 2) Public address system - The Public Address System at the railroad stations were utilized to the fullest extent during the last ten days before the election.
- 3) Lecture Meetings - Series of explanatory meetings were held in cities, towns and villages.
- 4) Prefectural Wall Paper - 2,500 copies of the wall paper covering the election were distributed to city, town and village offices.
- 5) Pref. Magazine - An article entitled, "Election for Members of City, Town and Village Land Commission" appeared in the Prefectural Magazine, THE ECHO.
- 6) Newspaper - The election was widely publicized in the local newspapers and the Techigi Section of the Tokyo newspapers. The SHIMOTSUKI printed the names of the newly elected commissioners in each city, town and village. A press release from this headquarters encouraging the eligible voters to go to the polls was released on the day of the election.
- 7) Posters and Leaflets - 4,000 posters and 120,000 leaflets were distributed to the cities, towns and villages.

f. Prominent campaign issues:

Communist Party:

- 1) Oppose to unlawful confiscation of farm land.
- 2) Oppose to withholding tax on price of delivered crops.
- 3) Oppose to high farm land rent.
- 4) Impartial exchange and distribution of farm land.

No prominent campaign issues of other political parties were noted or reported.

g. Political Strategy:

In general, political parties' campaign for this election in this Prefecture was not intensive.

The number of official candidates supported by the Communist Party was small compared to other major parties (Democratic Liberals - 211, Social Democrats - 158, etc). Communist Party was active throughout the Prefecture while other parties, e.g., Democratic Liberals, Social Democrats, etc, concentrated their campaigns in particular localities. Communist "cells" of each locality made every effort to assist their Party's candidates by campaigning at streets in the day time and speeches given at nights. Also election bills, posters and "Akahata" were utilized by these "cells". Average of approximately 25 people attended each of the speech meetings sponsored by these "cells". Communist Party's slogan was "Down with reactionary Yoshida Cabinet; Communist Party is the only one that's helping the working farmers". Commissioners of this Party also toured various towns and villages. Localities where communist was most active, the Democratic Liberal Party campaigned and expressed their anti-communistic attitude by speeches and utilizing posters. Democratic Liberal Party's slogan was "Down with the Communist Party and Japan Farmers' Union". AISON DOSHI KAI (Village Fellowship League), an anti-communist organization, also posted anti-Japan Farmers' Union posters in various localities. Counter measures such as above cost the Communist Party numerous votes. The Social Democrats Party stayed neutral and campaigned on their own. This party's candidates' speeches consisted the following subjects:

- 1) "Importance of Land Commission's duties".
- 2) "Construction of Democratic Japan".
- 3) "Unfulfilment of present cabinet's public promises".

Street speeches and distribution of election bills were utilized by all political parties. 61 localities where candidates were installed without opposition have, in general, conservative trend.

(3) There was no violation of election laws noted or reported to date.

1. On 18 August 1949 the voters of Tokyo-to elected their Agricultural Land Commissions. There were 1159 candidates, of which number 1055 were elected. The great majority of the successful candidates ran as independents-927. The political parties elected their candidates as follows: Democratic Liberal Party-70, the Democratic Party-11, the Social Democratic Party-35, the Communist Party-12, There were 101 places entitled to elect Commissions. In all but 4 the commissions were elected. In four places there were not the required number of candidates. Another election will be held in those places on 10 September 1949, These are, Toshima, Izu District; Miyake Village, Igaya District; Miyake Village and Mikaura. In 55 places, no polling took place as there were but 10 candidates - Legal required number of eligible voters were 68208 - of these 49720 actually voted. No violations of election laws were reported.
