## MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 5 – 2022

Sponsored by the Committee of Health & Social Welfare  
Chaired by: Coun. Brandy M. Palisoc

**Ordinance Prohibiting the Compounding, Dispensing, Selling or Reselling of Pharmaceutical Products Through Retail Drug Outlets Not Licensed by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and Providing Penalties For Violation Thereof**

**WHEREAS**, from January 13 to February 11, 2022, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) received 185 reports on sari-sari stores that were illegally selling medicines of which 78 were confirmed guilty;

**WHEREAS**, on Sec. 30 of R.A. No. 10918 or otherwise known as "Philippine Pharmacy Act" states that FDA licensed retail drug outlets or pharmacies are allowed to sell drugs and medicine to the consuming public;

**WHEREAS**, DILG issued Memorandum Circular No. 2022 - 025 to all Provincial and Local Government Units regarding the dispensing, selling and reselling of pharmaceutical products in sari-sari store;

**WHEREAS**, Sec. 447 of RA 7160, the Sangguniang Bayan as a legislative body of the municipality shall enact ordinances and measures for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, on Sec. 16 of the same Code states that the Municipal Government has the implied power to do all things necessary, appropriate or incidental to govern, efficiently and effectively, promote general welfare, promote health and safety, maintain peace and order and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, any sari-sari store/retail outlet may sell, dispense and resell over the counter medicines provided that they have complied and secure a license to operate from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA);

**WHEREAS**, Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued Advisory No. 2020 - 1348 public health warning against the purchase and use of the counterfeit products that proliferated in the market;

**WHEREFORE**, upon motion by Hon. Councilor Brandy M. Palisoc, unanimously seconded by the Sangguniang Bayan Members present;

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Sangguniang Bayan, Urbiztondo, Pangasinan in session assembled that:

**Section 1. Title.** This Ordinance shall be known as the "**Ordinance Prohibiting Compounding, Dispensing, Selling or Reselling of Pharmaceutical Products Through Retail Drug Outlets Not Licensed by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and Providing Penalties For Violation Thereof**"

**Sec. 2. Declaration of Policy.** It is hereby the policy of the State to protect and promote the right of health of the people and instill health consciousness among them as provided in Sec 15 Art 11 of the Constitution.

**Sec. 3. Definition of Terms.** As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall be understood to mean, thus:

- a. **Reselling** - sell something one has bought to someone else.
- b. **Counterfeit Drug** - products deliberately produced and/or mislabeled with respect to identity and/or source to make it appear to be a genuine product. It is a drug which is deliberately and fraudulently mislabeled with respect to identity and/or source or with fake packaging and can apply to both branded and generic products. It shall also refer to:
  - i. the drug itself or the container or labeling bearing without authorization, the trademark, trade name or other identification mark or imprint or any likeness to which is owned or registered in the Bureau of Patent, Trademark, Technology Transfer (BPTTT) in the name of another natural or juridical person;
  - ii. a drug refilled in containers by unauthorized persons if the legitimate labels or marks are used;
  - iii. an unregistered imported drug product, except drugs bought from other country for personal use as confirmed and justified by a medical records;
  - iv. a drug which contains no amount of or a different active ingredient or less than eighty percent (80%) of the active ingredient it purports to possess as distinguished from an adulterated drug including reduction or loss or efficacy due to expiration.
- c. **Food and Drug Administration** is the agency responsible for licensing, monitoring and regulation of cosmetics, drugs, foods, household hazardous products, medical devices and electromagnetic radiation emitting devices, pesticides, tobacco and related products, and vaccines for safety, efficacy and quality in the Republic of the Philippines.
- d. **Dispensing** refers to the process of preparing and giving medicine to a named person on the basis of a prescription.
- e. **Selling** is a transaction where goods or services is being exchanged for money.
- f. **Drugs** refers to any chemical compound or biological substance, other than food, intended for use in the treatment, prevention or diagnosis of disease in man.

- g. **Compounding** is generally a practice in which licensed pharmacist, a licensed physician, or, in the case of an outsourcing facility, a person under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist, combines, mixes, or alters ingredients of a drug to create a medication tailored to the needs of an individual patient.
- h. **Business establishment** shall refer to any entity whether a single proprietorship, partnership or corporation engaged in business in the municipality.
- i. **Owner** shall refer to a person or group of persons who is the registered owner of a license to operate a business or businesses undertaking in the municipality.
- j. **Household remedies** refer to any preparation containing pharmaceutical substances of common or ordinary use to relieve common physical ailments and which may be dispensed without a medical prescription in original packages, bottles or containers, of which the nomenclature has been duly approved by the FDA.
- k. **Sari-Sari tores** refer to retailing stores selling a general line of merchandise, classified as micro-enterprises.
- l. **LTO** - License to Operate
- m. **Over- the- Counter Medicine** refer to medicine used to symptomatic relief of minor ailments and which may be dispensed without a prescription.

**Sec. 4. Prohibited Acts.**

- a. The sale, dispensing, reselling, brokering or possession of counterfeit drugs or any drugs as defined in Sec. 3 hereof otherwise covered by RA No. 3720, as amended. The presence or availability of such counterfeit drugs or over the counter drugs within the premises of any entity engaged in the sale, dispensing, reselling in any sari-sari store or retail outlets shall constitute a prima facie evidence of violation of this ordinance.
- b. Sari-sari stores and other similar retail outlets and micro-enterprises are prohibited from dispensing, selling, or reselling prescription and pharmacist-only OTC medicines, as defined and classified by the FDA, as these medicines may only be dispensed by or obtained from a licensed pharmacist and with said licensed pharmacist's advice, pursuant to RA 10918.
- c. No pharmaceutical product of whatever nature and kind shall be compounded, dispensed, sold or resold or otherwise be made available to the consuming public except through a retail drug outlet duly licensed by the FDA.
- d. Any owner of the sari-sari store or owner of retail outlets is not authorized to sell, resell or dispense over the counter medicines without permit from the FDA – Food and Drug Administration as enumerated in Sec. 5 and shall be penalized under Sec. 11.
- e. Other stores such as convenience stores, cooperative-run stores, and other small and medium enterprises which intend to sell household remedies and OTC drugs (other than pharmaceutical stores) are first required to apply as a retail outlet for non-prescription drugs (RONPD) pursuant to FDA Circular No. 2014 - 028) and secure the following:
  - i. A license to operate (LTO) from the FDA;
  - ii. The employment supervision and oversight of a duly registered and licensed pharmacist pursuant to Section 31 (b) of RA 10918; and
  - iii. Other requirements imposed by the FDA on its LTO applicants.

**Sec. 5. Pharmacy – Only Over the Counter Medicines/Drugs.** The following medicines/drugs which are commonly sold in licensed pharmacies and at retail outlets shall be prohibited in sari-sari stores and similar business establishments:

**Sec. 7. Role of Barangay.** The Barangay Governments thru the Barangay Health Workers are directed to assist the municipal government in enforcement of this ordinance which may be carried out through the following acts:

- a. Information, education and communication efforts on these regulations for the benefit of the barangay residents;

- b. If necessary, referring violators to the municipal government and/or PNP for apprehension; and
- c. Integration of these guidelines and regulations in their barangay permit system requirements.

**Sec. 8. Role of Local Government Unit.**

- a. The LGU shall ensure the integration of these guidelines and regulations in their existing business permit and licensing systems and requirements.
- b. LGU shall also establish mechanism designed to assist the sari-sari store owners and other retail stores in securing proper authorization from the FDA to dispense, sell and resell pharmaceutical products.

**Sec. 9. Agencies/Offices To Enforce and Implement this Ordinance.** The following agencies/offices are tasked and enjoined to provide assistance and utilize all their available resources as are necessary for the implementation and enforcement of this Ordinance. The lead agency is the Office of the Municipal Health Officer, BPLO – Business Permit and Licensing Officer and the coordinating agencies/offices are the PNP Urbiztondo under the leadership of the Chief of Police and Barangay Officials/Tanods who shall apprehend the owners of sari-sari store who are dispensing, selling and reselling pharmaceutical products within their territorial jurisdiction.

**Sec. 10. Penalty.** Any individual or owner of sari-sari store/owner of retail outlets found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be charged with the following penalties:

- a. First Offense - Php500.00
- b. Second Offense - Php1,500.00
- c. Third Offense and subsequent offense - Php2,500.00 plus imprisonment of not less than or more than six months upon the discretion of the court and cancellation or revocation of his/her business permit for a period of one year

**Sec. 11. Repealing Clause.** All existing ordinances, rules and regulations, as well as orders inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

*file* **Sec. 12. Separability.** Should any of these clauses or parts of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, all other remaining portions not so declared shall remain valid and effective.

**Sec. 13. Effectivity.** This ordinance shall take effect upon favorable review and approval by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days upon its publication in a newspaper of local circulation pursuant to and in conformity with pertinent provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A. 7160).
