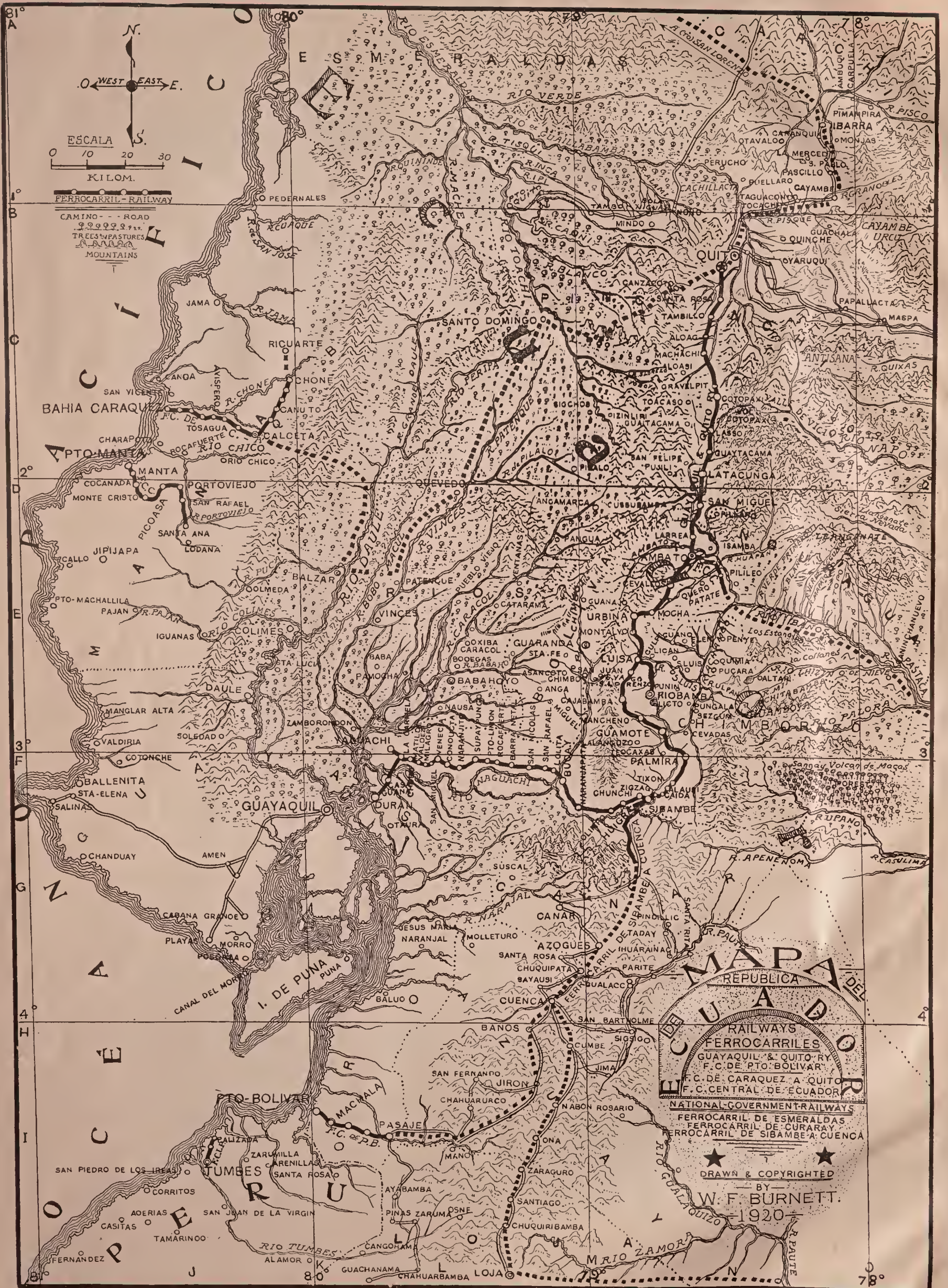

Cities and Towns of Commercial Importance Along Guayaquil & Quito Railway

Guayaquil, capital of the Province of Guayas, has a population of 80,000 and is the chief port of the Republic of Ecuador.

All the principal importing and exporting houses of the Republic are located at this port. Vessels can lay close in and are unloaded by tenders. Principal products are cocoa, coffee, cotton, rubber, hides, etc.

Industries: Sugar mills, tannery, breweries and soap and candle factories, saw mills, tanneries, ship building, etc. See Commercial Directory for list of Importers and Exporters.

Rainy season, January to April, dry season, June to November; summer December to May. It is advisable to visit Republic during the dry season to avoid any possibility of taking the fever, though Guayaquil is practically safe now from yellow fever since sanitary conditions have been put into effect.

Hotels—Paris, Gral Victoria, Capricho, Mediterraneo, Cosmopolitan and Wellington.

Banks—See directory on page 6.

Duran—Population 1000. Terminus G. & Q. Ry. Lies on east bank of Guayas River opposite Guayaquil.

Huigra, Province de Chimborazo—Population 600. On G. & Q. Ry., and on the State Railway now building to Cuenca. Shipping point for freight in Provinces of Canar, Azuay and Loja, such as Canar, Azogues, Cuenca, Banos, etc.

Guamote, Province de Chimborazo—Population 9000. Important commercial center. Industries: Agriculture, mining, etc.

Ambato, capital of the Provincia de Tunuragua—Population 12,500. Located near the bottom of the Volcano Chimborazo. Principal industries and products: Maize, barley, wheat, cochineal, strawberries and various fruits. Hotels: Victoria, Babk Samaniega y Cia. Travelers will do well to include this town in their itinerary.

RIVER SERVICE FROM GUAYAQUIL AND DURAN

To Rio Daule, Rio Bobo, Rio Caracol, Rio Guayas, Rio Bodegas and Other Points.

Babahoyo (Bodegas), capital of Provincia de Los Rios—Population 5000. On Rio Bodegas, 64 kilom. from Guayaquil. Daily boat service. Products and Industries: Maize, cocoa, sugar cane, rice, wax, lumber, gold, mercury, silver, cattle, timber, etc.

Daule, Provincia de Guayas—Population 14,000. Lies on east bank of Rio Daule. Regular steamer service maintained from Guayaquil. Products: Hides, cattle, rice, coffee, cocoa, sugar, caotchouc, etc.

Balzar, Provincia de Guayas—Population 5500. Located on Rio Daule. Reached by boats from Duran. Products: Coffee, cacao, tobacco, caotchouc, sugar, dye woods, cattle, etc.

Bahia de Caraquez is a port with 8500 population. Products exported: Ivory, nuts, sugar, coffee, hides, etc. U. S. Consular Agent is located at this port. Lloyds Agent, M. Pierre Discomps. Custom Brokers: Suc. ed Alejandro Santos. Bank: Banco Comercial y Agrícola. Hotels: Alejandro Santos and Gregorio Usivoich.

While there is some direct importing done by firms of this city, most supplies are secured from Guayaquil firms.

Principal products along this line is cacao, coffee, sugar cane, cotton, rubber, vanilla, copper, coal. Portoviejo, a city of 10,000 population, has the following industries: Fishing, mining, manufacture of panama hats, baskets and hammocks. Principal hotel: Hotel Bolivar. On account of not being on main line of travel few foreign salesmen make this town, Guayaquil being the principal source of supply for its merchants.

BILLS OF EXCHANGE WITH ECUADOR

Importers desiring to engage in import business with Ecuador and desiring to purchase same outright opens an account with some local bank in Guayaquil on which the seller can draw, or if goods are shipped by the Ecuador exporter on consignment to some firm in the United States it is customary for the New York, New Orleans, San Francisco or Los Angeles importer to notify the seller that he has an open account with a specified bank in the United States that he can draw through upon surrender of a full set of bills of lading. Most bills of lading are made 30 to 60 days sight on the United States and 90 days on Europe. As Guayaquil is generally the maker of these drafts it is naturally where same is made payable.

Latacunga, capital of the Provincia de Leon—Population 10,000. A very rich mining country lies tributary to this city, some of the oldest and richest mines in the Republic lay to the east of this city. Industries and products: Sugar, cotton, woolen mills, cattle raising, gold, copper and silver mines. Hotel: Italia. The volcano Cotopaxi lies 29 kilom. from this city.
