SUBJECT: Reporting of Explosive Ordnance Targets

TO: Chief, Tokai-Hokuriku Civil Affairs Region, APO 710
Chief, Kinki Civil Affairs Region, APO 25
Chief, Shikoku Civil Affairs Region, APO 1050

1. The Ordnance Officer, Eighth Army, has designated certain bomb-disposal squads to collect and dispose of all explosive ordnance targets discovered within prefectural areas. The Japanese police authorities have been informed by Public Safety Division, G-2, SCAP, to make a monthly report by mail direct to the designated squad, on a form provided by the Ordnance Officer, giving the target location, police station having jurisdiction, information regarding target and other pertinent information. In emergencies the Japanese police authorities notify direct the squad for the area concerned or the provost marshal of the area, by the fastest means of communication. In all cases the designated bomb disposal squad will collect and dispose of the target.

2. Any report of explosive ordnance discovered within your area shall be referred to the appropriate Japanese police authorities for disposition as they have been informed.

3. For your information the Bomb Disposal Office Ordnance Section, 25th Infantry Division, APO 25, located at Osaka, is responsible for Toyama, Ishikawa, Gifu, Aichi, Fukui, Kyoto, Mie, Wakayama, Nara, Osaka, Shiga, Hyogo, Tottori, Okayama, Kagawa, Kochi, Ehime and Tokushima prefectures.

1. Reference is letter, Headquarters Osaka Military Government Team, subject: "Manufacture and Use of Industrial Explosives", dated 3 February 1949.

2. Referenced letter authorized the Ishiwara Kakohin Kogyosho, 909 Minamikata-machi, Higashi-Yodogawa-ku, Osaka City, to produce 9,500 signal firing devices for ships in the calendar year 1949.

3. Information has been received from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, that producers who participated in the 1949 production plan may, pending announcement of the 1950 plan, begin production in 1950 of industrial explosives on the basis of the amount and types authorized for 1949.

4. It is requested that the Ishiwara Kakohin Kogyosho be informed that production in 1950 of 9,500 signal firing devices for ships is authorized pending issuance of the 1950 production plan.

3. Information has been received from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, that producers who participated in the 1949 production plan may, pending announcement of the 1950 plan, begin production in 1950 of industrial explosives on the basis of the amounts and types authorized for 1949.

4. It is requested that the Nippon Kayaku K.K. be informed that production in 1950 of 28,170,000 blasting caps and 60,000 signal detonators is authorized pending issuance of the 1950 production plan.

- b. Letter, Headquarters I Corps (AG 471-R), dated 22 October 1946, as amended, subject: "Instructions on Munitions Locating and Reporting";
- c. Letter, Headquarters 25th Infantry Division, Office of the Ordnance Officer, dated 16 November 1948, subject: "Munitions Locating and Reporting".

2. Current reorganization of Civil Affairs units necessitates a reconsideration of many reports required from the Japanese and which were submitted to the prefectural Civil Affairs teams. The report required by reference 1c above is a monthly report submitted to the teams, who forward the report to Headquarters 25th Infantry Division. With the deactivation of the prefectural teams, there will be no local unit to receive the report. This headquarters has observed that the Japanese police reports munition locations as soon as they are discovered. These spot reports are forwarded to your headquarters as they are received.

3. This headquarters is anxious to reduce to a minimum the number of reports called for from the Japanese. An opinion is desired on the possibility of discontinuing the Monthly Munitions Report.

SUBJECT: Report of Explosives Production

1. It is desired that all industrial explosives produced in the Kinki Region be reported to this headquarters on a monthly basis.

2. The first report will be for November 1949, and will reach this headquarters not later than 5 December 1949. Subsequent reports will arrive not later than the 5th day of the month following the reported period.

3. The reports will contain production data as cited below. A sample form for preparation of the report is inclosed herewith:

a. The kind and quantity of all explosives produced in the Kinki Region during the reported month, each listed separately opposite the name and address of the producer.

b. The subject and date of the letter authorizing the production of each item reported.

c. The monthly quantity authorized for production.

4. In addition to the production data outlined above the reports will describe any construction of new explosive production facilities and/or conversion of existing production facilities which took place during the reported month. New construction and/or conversion will be reported only once, and will not be included in subsequent reports. Negative reports are not required.
