Cabinet Order No. 28

Sodium Mono-Fluoroacetate Handling Standards Order

In accordance with the provision of Article 16 paragraph 1 of the Law for Control of Poisonous and Powerful Agents (Law No. 303 of 1950), the Cabinet establishes this Cabinet Order.

(Restriction of Use)

Article 1. Sodium mono-fluoroacetate shall not be used for any other purpose than the making of its preparations.

2 Sodium mono-fluoroacetate preparations shall not be used for any other purpose than the extermination of field-mice carried out by the local public body, agricultural cooperative association or agricultural mutual relief association.

(Preparations)

Article 2. In case sodium mono-fluoroacetate preparations are made with the sodium mono-fluoroacetate, such preparations shall be made in accordance with each item of the following standards:

- (1) That they shall be made into water solutions of not more than 2%;
- (2) That they shall be colored in crimson;
- (3) That the tincture of cayenne pepper which comes under the standard prescribed in the Japanese Pharmacopoeia, and is condensed into such denser form as 1/5 shall be mixed in the water solution at the capacity ratio of not less than 1 %.

(Indication to be Attached to Containers)

Article 3. Any person who has manufactured or imported the sodium mono-fluoroacetate preparations shall make an indication stating the following particulars on each container of the sodium

mono-fluoroacetate preparations manufactured or imported by him:

- (1) That it contains a sodium mono-fluoroacetate preparation and the quantity thereof;
- (2) That the sodium mono-fluoroacetate preparation shall not be used for any other purpose than the extermination of field-mice;
- (3) That when the sodium mono-fluoroacetate preparation in the container has been entirely consumed, the consumer shall dispose of such container in such a manner as may preclude the possibility of causing danger to the public health and sanitation.

(Directions for Use)

Article 4. In case the sodium mono-fluoroacetate preparation is used for the extermination of field-mice, each item of the following standards of operating procedure shall be complied with:

- (1) That it shall be carried out under the guidance of the part-time plant disease and pest control agent prescribed in Article 33 paragraph 1 of the Plant Quarantine Law (Law No. 151 of 1950) or the technical adviser prescribed in Article 14 paragraph 1 of the Law concerning Improvement and Promotion of Agriculture (Law No. 165 of 1948) who may be designated by the governor of To, Do, Fu or prefecture;
- (2) That the quantity of sodium mono-fluoroacetate contained in a piece of bait shall be 3 milligrams or less;
- (3) That the bait shall not be placed on the ground;
- (4) That in case the bait has been placed, the remainder of bait shall be disposed of in such a manner as may preclude the possibility of causing danger to the public health and sanitation;
- (5) That the public announcement shall be made for a week before and after the carrying out of the control as to the time and area concerning such control.

(Disposition of Empty Containers)

Article 5. When the sodium mono-fluoroacetate preparation contained in a container has been entirely consumed, the consumer shall dispose of such emptied container in such a manner as may preclude the possibility of causing danger to the public health and sanitation.

(Exception)

Article 6. Those provisions of Articles 1, 2 and 4 shall not apply to the case where those who handle the sodium mono-fluoroacetate or its preparations for experiment or research purposes have been authorized to do so by the Minister of Welfare.

Supplementary Provision:

This Cabinet Order shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

MINISTERIAL ORDINANCES

Ministry of Welfare Ordinance No. 6

February 22, 1952

The Enforcement Regulation of the Food Sanitation Law (Ministry of Welfare Ordinance No. 23 of July, 1948) shall be partially amended as follows:

Article 4 shall be amended as follows:
Article 4. Deleted.

Article 5 shall be amended as follows:

Article 5. The foodstuffs and additional things to be labeled according to the provision of Article 11 of the Law shall be fixed as follows; but those to be exported shall be excepted from the rule:

- (1) The foodstuffs, other than cream, fermented milk, butter, cheese, and other daily products prescribed in Article 2 paragraph 7 of the Ministerial Ordinance in Regard to the Ingredient Standards, etc. of Milk and Daily Products (Ministry of Welfare Ordinance No. 52 of December, 1951) (hereinafter referred to as "the dairy products"), that have milk (including secondary products; hereinafter the same) as their chief material (excluding ice-cream), and margarine;
- (2) Ham, Sausage, bacon and the like;
- (3) Alcoholic drinks (which shall be construed to mean the drinks containing more than 1 capacity percentage; hereinafter the same);
- (4) Soft drinks (which shall be construed to mean the drinks containing carbonic acid or organic acid and having an acid taste, which are put in the containers or packages for preservation; hereinafter the same) and preservative drinks (which shall be construed to mean

the drinks without any acid taste and puting the containers or packages for preservation; hereinafter the same);

- (5) Lunch, plain food and cake or pastry, put in the containers or packages;
- (6) Chemical compounds used as additional things, and preparations containing these;
- (7) Canned, bottled or barreled foodstuffs other than those specified in the preceding items.

Article 6 paragraph 1 shall be amended as follows:

The labels of the foodstuffs and the additional things specified in the items of the preceding Article shall be made by the manufacturers (in the case of the imports, importers; hereinafter the same) specifying the following matters on the part easily seen of the container or package:

- (1) Name (market name); but, in the cases of the chemical compounds used as additional things (excluding the synthetic spices), the names as shown in Appendix No. 2, shall be used:
- (2) Date of manufacturing; but, in the case of cream, the week day for the sale thereof may be substituted therefore, and, in the cases of alcoholic drinks, soft drinks and chemical compounds (including the preparations containing these), this may be omitted;
- (3) Location of the manufacturing plant (in the cases of the imports, the location of the business office of the importer; hereinafter, the same), and name of the manufacturer (in the case of the juridical person, the title thereof);
- of alcoholic drinks (excluding beer), the ingredients and the weight percentage of each of these for the whole weight in the cases of the preparations containing chemical compounds (excluding synthetic spices), and, in the cases of the canned bottled or barreled foodstuffs containing synthetic dressings, synthetic spices, synthetic preservatives, synthetic sterilizers or synthetic starches, the facts;
- (5) In the cases of the additional things, the standards to the usages of which have been fixed by the provision of Article 7 of the Law, the usages in accordance with the same standards

Article 7 shall be amended as follows:

Article 7. Deleted.

In Article 8 paragraph 1 item (5), "the copy of analysis table of the component, if possible" shall be amended as "the analysis table of the component", in item (6) of the same paragraph, "to kubetsu yoto (special purpose)" as "tokubetsu no yoto (special purpose)", and, next to the same item, the following one item shall be added:

(7) Matters prescribed in Article 9 item (6) and item (7).

Article 9 shall be amended as follows:

Article 9. As to the foodstuffs and the additional things, which, with the permission by Minister of Welfare according to the provision of Article 13 of the Law, are going to be labeled the fact of their being fitted for the special usages prescribed in the same Article, the matters specified in Article 6 paragraph 1 item (1) to item (4) inclusive, and the following matters shall be specified on the parts easily seen of the containers or packages thereof; but, as to the matters approved by Minister of Welfare, the labeling thereof may be omitted:

- (1) Permit number;
- (2) Special usage;
- (3) Reasons for fitness for special usage;
- (4) Proportion of combination of raw materials;
- (5) Components Analysis Table and amounts of efficacious calories;
- (6) In case that the permission of labeling the fitness for the special usage because of its containing vitamins, inorganic salts and other specific matter, contents of such matters and amounts of such matters generally required per day by the user of such foodstuff or additional things;
- (7) In the case of those requiring special caution as to the method if cooking, using or preserving it, such precautions;
- (8) In case that the person who has obtained the permission under the provisions of Article 13 of the Law is one other than the manufacturer, location of the business office and name (in the case of a juridical person, its title) of one who has obtained the permission.

In Article 10 item (1), "ethyl rhodanacetate and its preparations" shall be deleted.

Article 11 item (3) and item (5) shall be amended as follows:

- (3) Location of manufacturing plant;
- (5) Quantity applied.

In Article 12, "in case of ethyl rhodanacetate and its preparations, per 100 kg" shall be struck out.

Item (2) in the column of Products Examination Ledger of Article 15-(2) shall be amended as follows:

- (2) Names of products and quantities applied; In Article 16, paragraph 3 shall be deleted.
- In Article 17 item (3), "or veterinary science" shall be amended as "veterinary science, zootechny, fisheries or agricultural science".

In Article 18 paragraph 2, "shall be in accordance with Appendix, Form No. 3" shall be amended as "shall be in accordance with Appendix, Form 3, and the badge denoting him to be

the food inspector shall be in accordance with Appendix, Form No. 3-2".

Article 18-(2) shall be amended as follows:

Article 18-(2). Governor of To, Do, Fu and prefectures or the mayors of the cities with the health centers established, when they have the food inspectors conduct the supervision and guidance on the facilities handling foodstuffs, shall have them give marks on these facilities as prescribed in Appendix, No. 2-2, and draw up the foodstuff inspection cards under Appendix, Form No. 4, and shall have the copies thereof sticked on the inside of the same facilities.

The foodstuff inspection cards under the preceding paragraph shall be kept at least for 1 year by the health centers.

Article 19-(2) shall be deleted.

Article 20 item (5) shall be amended as follows:

(5) Outline of business equipments.

To the same Article, the following one paragraph shall be added:

When those who have obtained the approval of the business under the provision of Article 21 of the Law intend to obtain the approval of the same business to be continued at the expiration of the term of validity of the same approval, the following matters shall be stated in the written application, irrespective of each of the items of the preceding paragraph:

- (1) Matters specified in item (1) and item (2) of the preceding paragraph;
- (2) Number of the approval of business actually obtained.

In Article 21, "the preceding Article shall be amended as "paragraph 1 of the preceding Article", and paragraph 2 shall be deleted.

Article 21-(2) and Article 21-(3) shall be deleted.

Article 22 shall be amended as follows:

Article 22. Deleted.

In Article 25 paragraph 1, "and be appointed by Minister of Welfare, prefectural governor or mayor" shall be amended as "and be appointed by Minister of Welfare".

Article 26 item (1) shall be amended as follows:

(1) Address and name of physician;



- 2 As to the labeling of foodstuffs or additional things which have actually been approved by Minister of Welfare according to the provision of Article 13 of the Law at the time of the enforcement of this Ministerial Ordinance, the former precedents shall still be followed exclusively for 1 year from the day of the enforcement of this Ministerial Ordinance, irrespective of the provision of Article 9.
- 3 As to the toys manufactured before the enforcement of this Ministerial Ordinance, the former precedents shall still be followed exclusively for 6 months from the day of the enforcement of this Ministerial Ordinance, irrespective of the provision of Article 26-(2).
- 4 As to the additional things and the preparations and foodstuffs containing these, which have gone through the product inspection under the provision of Article 14 of the Law prior to the enforcement of this Ministerial Ordinance, the former precedents shall still be followed exclusively for 3 months from the day of the enforcement of this Ministerial Ordinance, irrespective of the provision of Article 3.


