Poultry Owners: Don't Haul Disease Home!

Before you go home...

- Wash your hands.
- Wash and disinfect your shoes and equipment.
- Clean and disinfect car and truck tires.

When you get home...

- Change clothes immediately.
- Wash the clothes you were wearing in HOT water.
- Isolate birds you bring home for at least 3 weeks.



- 1 PRACTICE GOOD BIOSECURITY AT HOME.**
Restrict traffic onto and off your property.
Disinfect shoes, clothes, and equipment.
Wash your hands.

- 2 KNOW THE WARNING SIGNS OF DISEASE.**
Watch for signs of disease
or unexpected deaths among
your birds.



- 3 REPORT SICK BIRDS!**
