MEMORANDUM FOR: IMPERIAL JAPANESE GOVERNMENT
THROUGH: Central Liaison Office, Tokyo
SUBJECT: Release of German-owned Goods

1. The Imperial Japanese Government is directed to release from the provisions of memorandum for the Imperial Japanese Government, file AG 091.112(13 Sep 45)MG, Scapin 26, 13 September 1945, subject, "Protection of Allied and Axis Property" from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, the following German-owned goods at the locations indicated:

2. The above mentioned goods will be relinquished to the Japanese Ministry of Commerce and Industry who will contact the Industry Division of the Economic and Scientific Section of General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers as to instructions regarding their disposition.

3. These goods will be distributed in accordance with allocations made as per instructions in paragraph 2 and sold at official government prices.

4. All funds derived from the sale of these goods will be deposited in the Custody Account for the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers and a complete report submitted to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

5. The contents of this memorandum shall not be construed to release other goods from the blocking provisions of any other memorandum issued by General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers or any ordinance promulgated by the Imperial Japanese Government.
