



#### Beginning

- Bulgarian Archives State Agency (BASA) is responsible for the conservation and documentation of government and historical records, and allowing public access to them.
- Collaboration with BG Wikipedia was initiated by BASA's Director, Assoc. Prof. Martin Ivanov, in November 2011,
- Ivanov was inspired by a lecture about US
   Archives' collaboration with the US Wikimedian community.



#### Timeline





- Archival issues:
  - Late archives digitization in BG
  - Poor document descriptions and metadata
  - Almost all catalogues are on paper and unsearchable
  - Few documents available at a time



- Technical issues:
  - Equipment: own laptops, cameras and scanners
  - Good free wifi connection provided by BASA
  - New accounts: 'BASA <account>' for easier tracking of project-related contributions

- Content issues: What we digitize?
  - Illustrative content: people, places, events, etc.
  - Documents: acts, statutes, newspaper clips, etc.
    - Can be OCR-ed and used as primary sources



#### • Results:

- 6100 + scanned and uploaded documents
- In Bulgarian Wikipedia: 1278
- In other languages: 908
- In Wikidata: 252
- Distinct images used: 1267 (20.50% of all) \*
- Number of new articles created: 119


Idea: To encourage

- Improvement of the file descriptions in different languages,
- Addition of more categories and making the documents easier to find,
- Better utilization of the BASA content:
  - Addition of the images to articles
  - Creation of articles, based on the images.



Internationalization:

- The challenge was originally oriented towards the Bulgarian Wikimedia Community.
- However, we soon made it international by:
  - Promoting it among our friends from Central and Eastern Europe (via the Facebook group)
  - Encouraging users to contribute in English.
  - Creating a coordination page on Meta and getting it translated in German and Spanish.



• Results:

13 participants from 7 language versions

Created descriptions: 3202

Edited descriptions: 268

Added categories: 2387

Images added to articles: 597

New articles:
 94 (454 500 bytes)

Pairs of "Then and Now" images: 57



#### Future plans

2016 Edition of the Archives Challenge:

We hope to repeat the successful contest from 2015 by:

- Attracting more editors in different languages
- Getting at least 1/3 of all BASA images used in articles in different languages (currently 1/5)
- Getting more written articles in foreign languages (huge potential here!)
- Inspiring other national archives and wiki communities to organize similar challenges



#### Future plans

- Planning a PEG grant for a travelling exhibition:
  - Organizing exhibitions major cities in Bulgaria
  - Showing the best examples of the GLAM collab between BG WP and BASA,

#### - Aims:

- Deepening the Wikipedia / Archives relation
- Creating contacts with other GLAM institutions
- Improving the contacts with local Wikimedians
- Contacting and educating local media
- Producing more free content.
