How rephotography is used in Wikimedia context?

With rephotography we experiment how to approach interesting ways to explore and geotag photos from open repositories.

In Wiki Loves Monuments 2018 photo competition we had a rephotography track for photographing places depicted in historical photographs with mobile app Ajapaik. We continue this by taking part in Hack4FI hackathon with photos from WLM.

Through this we try to give existing editors new ways to contribute and reach out to new contributors.

Why, what is in rephotography for...

Me- User: Choosing photos is editorial process; orientation, getting to know: historical or own environment, change in architecture, urban landscape, photography, photography history.

You - Affiliate: Active use to open licensed photos, their geolocation, increased interest in photo archives and museums. Iteration: rephoto after 50 years?

Us – Wikimedia: Geotagged photos, upload photos into Commons and more illustrations to Wikipedia articles.
