1. The addressees are authorized to grant absences but will control the issuance of passes and approval of leave to ensure sufficient personnel are in their immediate area to accomplish necessary tasks and, if necessary, initiate disaster and emergency alert plans.

a. Absences over three days require written orders authorizing leave and travel to specific points.

b. Applications for passes or leaves within Japan will indicate:

- (1) Location of billet while on leave and evidence that reservation is confirmed.
- (2) Type of billet, i.e., rest hotel, private home.
- (3) Enlisted personnel except when on official duty, will not be on the streets between 2400 and 0600 hours.

2. The provisions of par 3a (Leaves) and 4 (Passes) Sec XIII, Weekly Directive No. 19, Hq Japan Logistical Command dated 6 January 1951 will govern the issuance of leaves and passes for personnel in the Civil Affairs Regions. All
