

CHAFFEE, JEROME B.

EX-SENATOR JEROME B. CHAFFEE died a few days since at the residence of his son-in-law, Ulysses S. Grant, Salem Centre, N. Y., aged sixty-one years. He was born in Niagara county, N. Y.; went West in his youth; amassed a fortune in Colorado, where he entered the legislature, becoming speaker of the house; served two terms in Congress as territorial delegate, and when Colorado became a State in 1876 was elected United States Senator as a Republican. He lost \$500,000 by the Grant & Ward failure. His son-in-law was General Grant's youngest son.
