



Five Pillars

WIKIPEDIA IS AN ENCYCLOPEDIA

- Everything does not fit in an encyclopedia, there is a notability criteria
- No original research
- There is a manual of style for the text

EDITORS SHOULD TREAT EACH OTHER WITH RESPECT AND CIVILITY

- Respect your fellow wikipedians, even when you don't agree
- Never use Wikipedia as a battleground

FREE CONTENT THAT ANYONE CAN USE, EDIT AND DISTRIBUTE

- All users license their work under free license, so anyone can use it – even for commercial reasons
- Free of charge
- High standards concerning personal integrity

A NEUTRAL POINT OF VIEW

- Wikipedia characterize information and issues rather than debate them, presenting different opinions where such exist
- No commercials of any kind

WIKIPEDIA HAS NO FIRM RULES

- There are policies and guidelines, but they are always open for discussion
- Be bold!






