

TEMPLAR (H.T.). Bud medium size, globular; flower medium size, double, globular, very lasting. Vigorous, upright, abundant and continuous bloomer. A new forcing Rose which is making its way into the garden. Clear, bright red, of exceeding double form and with fine, strong stems, Few thorns, perfumed.
