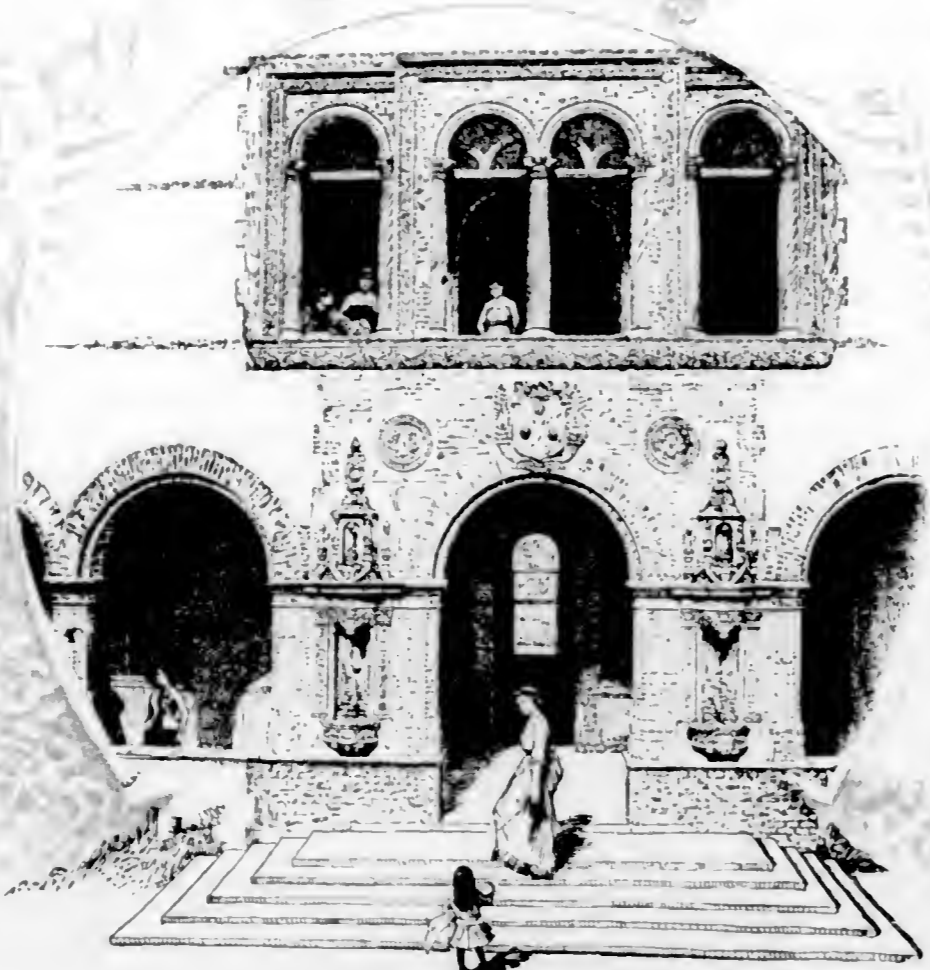


LADIES' ENTRANCE

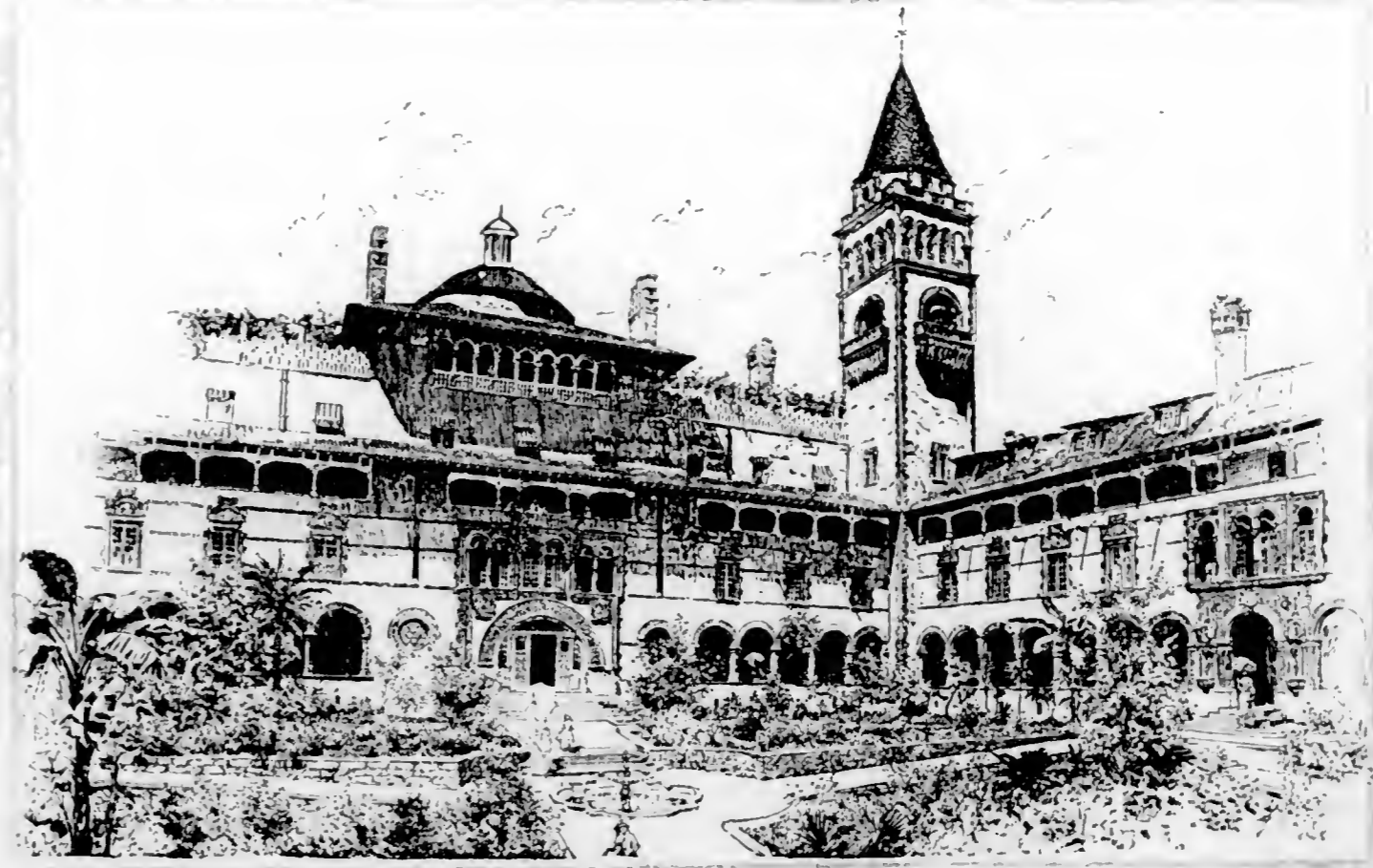
