E. Use of the machine in post-war time:

1. Since permission was obtained for reconversion to civil industry.

F. Reasons why it is necessary to retain the machine judging from a national economic point of view:

1. The machine is indispensable to the mass production of the farming tool necessary for staple food production, and of the forest cutting tool and earthwork tool for the recovery from the war and earthquake damage.

2. Materials are scarce, now, for making farming tool as others, and the machine is deemed as indispensable to process such materials.

3. We are making a greater number of the farming tool, forest cutting tool, or earthquake tool in Kochi Pref., and if we lose the machine, we are afraid if the production of the tool for the food production or the recovery from the war and earthquake damage will be impossible.

1. In compliance with letter your Headquarters A.S. 004 dated 7 February 1947, the following report is submitted.
2. All plants holding reparation machinery were last inspected for compliance with Scapin 1219 on the following dates 14, 15, 23, and 24 of January 1947.
3. The above inspection was made by an Enlisted Man, Commerce & Industry Section, Kochi Mil. Govt. Team and a member of the Kochi Branch of the Takamatsu Finance Bureau.
4. Five reparation machinery, property of Osaka Army Arsenal, have been repaired and are now in use by the Japanese. Two reparation machines formerly property of Kure Naval Arsenal are in operation.
5. It was necessary to give instruction to a few plants that had suffered earthquake damages to remove rust, oil machines and to provide proper covering.
6. The Kochi Branch of the Takamatsu Finance Bureau is the Japanese Agency responsible for the thirty-one pieces of reparation machinery in Kochi Prefecture.
7. The Commerce and Industry Section of the Team inspects all reparation machinery once a month. The Kochi Branch of the Takamatsu Finance Bureau make an inspection of all machines twice a month and submits a report to this Headquarters on the 10th and 25th of each month.
